





CLAIM 431 VINEYARD, CENTRAL OTAGO

Brits John and Jennifer Joslin were touring the world in their yacht in the 1990s when they made landfall in the Marlborough Sounds. What's not to love? They fell hard, and decided on the spot that making wine was the thing for them. They purchased land, prepared it for vine planting, and while still living in their yacht had a mud brick house built on site from local earth. And right there, folks, we have the birth of the Mud House wine brand. 21 years on, accompanied by some shifts in ownership, Mud House have gone on to earn an enviable reputation for their vinous output.

The winemaking team at Mud House is headed by Cleighten Cornelius, a viticulture and oenology graduate from Lincoln University. He gained serious winemaking experience in France and Germany before returning to NZ and joining Mud House in 2012. Cleighten heads up an experienced team that has been with the company pretty much since the beginning.

Their intimate knowledge of Marlborough's viticultural landscape and its unique flavour profiles has been the inspiration for Mud House's latest Sub Region Series; the Mud House estate wines are great value everyday drinking celebrating the crispness, aromatic depth and purity of flavour to be found in the South Island, while the Single Vineyard range harnesses fruit from individual sites in key Southern varietal growing regions to produce wines of considerable elegance and flair.

KUMEU



Located just north of a burgeoning Auckland, once a hotbed for the NZ wine industry and home to many of our pioneers (think Collards, Babich, Corbans). The Brajkovich family have survived the growth of our largest city, along with the challenges of the region, to craft some of our finest Chardonnay. The Auckland humidity does not make for easy winemaking, but the Brajkovich family's skill set sees off all obstacles.

WAIHEKE ISLAND

The island of Waiheke is an hour by ferry from the centre of Auckland and a magnet for every visiting celebrity with time on their hands. With its multitude of sub climates, Waiheke produces excellent wines in a wide variety of styles, the maritime climate and soils favouring Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Malbec for red wines and Chardonnay for white, with Pinot Gris particularly suited to satellite island, Ponui.

A veritable oasis for peaches, apples, pears and almost everything else, Gisborne's wines are also a variable mix. It is home to NZ's best nursery, Riversun, and as a result there is a good deal of experimentation going on. Where, once upon a time, most of the grapes were destined for sparkling wine production, Chardonnay is, these days, the ruling variety, though Chenin Blanc is right up there too. Merlot rules the reds.

A warm and historical region where Tom McDonald made many of New Zealand's early clarets, the famed gravels derived from river beds provide excellent soils for Cabernet, Merlot, Malbec and Petit Verdot, with the hillsides home to the increasingly successful Syrah. Cabernet blends, then, dominate the red landscape. The white variety of choice is Chardonnay, though the Bay's Sauvignon Blanc shouldn't be overlooked.





NELSON



Nelson can boast a long history of horticulture. Its relatively mild maritime climate combined with an excess of sunshine hours provides a good degree of fruit purity, with production small but quality high. Elegant and complex Chardonnay, restrained and mineral-infused Sauvignon Blanc, Fragrant Pinot Noir and a rich variety of aromatic wines are all on the Nelson vinous radar.

Home to boutique crafters of Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and the aromatic varieties, the Waipara Valley has been turning out critically-acclaimed wines since the 1970s. With its climate slightly warmer than the rest of Canterbury, Waipara's good sunshine and lengthy growing season deliver expressions that are becoming known for their ripe fruit, richly intense flavours and layers of complexity.



CENTRAL OTAGO



Down south, the juxtaposition of almost brutal daily and seasonal temperature extremes delivers immense concentration in the grapes. The wines here are vibrant with fresh acidity, the fruit lush and generous. Central Otago has divided into a number of individual subregions, each with their own climatic niche. Wanaka, Gibbston, Bannockburn, Alexandra, Bendigo and Cromwell all produce their own unique expressions.

BOUTIQUE CHIC

Matakana's great. Think 'green as' hills. Think 'blue as' skies. Actually, scrap that; think 'tasty as' beers. Matakana natives Sawmill have increasingly become a staple in not only craft beer digs, but restaurants, bars, and bottle shops of all descriptions. Here's why: if you like something traditional, just a casual pint or an easy drop, their 12 Gauge, Pilsner and Pale Ale are just a few examples of their true-to-style beers that whet whistles wonderfully. If you want to have your taste buds wrestled and your mind blown, how about you try their IPA, The Doctor or Session IPA? Both their IPA and their Pilsner are available in 6-packs now, so it's even easier to take with you.

The brewery was opened in 2004 in Leigh, where once stood a timber mill built in the 1860s. Now Sawmill has relocated the brewery to a new spot on Leigh road in Matakana, operating on a larger scale and opening their restaurant, the Smoko Room. Owners Mike and Kirsty reckon the "raw landscape has a bearing on everything." So maybe those 'green as' hills and 'blue as' skies are 'important as' after all.

QUARTZ REEF





Direct and to the point; loves to stir things up; adores vintage champagne; qualified viticulturist and winemaker; consummate creator when it comes to either Pinot Noir or méthode traditionnelle: these are all apt descriptors of Austrian-born Rudi Bauer.

Established in 1996 and named after New Zealand's largest quartz deposit that lies beneath the vineyards at Bendigo Station, Quartz Reef has become the vessel for what winemaker Rudi Bauer calls his search to make wines that exhibit 'a symphony of flavours that capture attention and entertain so that you forget everything else'.

Rudi's Pinot Noir is world-class, and his superb méthodes champion brilliantly the true potential of our southernmost regions for sparkling wine, produced as they are entirely from his own estate-grown fruit, a la Grower champagnes.

He is a strong advocate of biodynamics, and Quartz Reef's two 15-hectare Bendigo vineyards are strictly and passionately managed by the principles developed by fellow Austrian, Rudolf Steiner. The management regime of the biodynamic Demeter-Certified vineyards is both arduous and time consuming, but the results speak for themselves.

Quartz Reef wines are produced entirely in-house, from vineyard through to bottling, ensuring the total quality control and consistency that have earned them accolades everywhere.

While you might find the more obvious rockstars of New Zealand's alcoholic beverage landscape within the worlds of winemaking and craft brewing, there is no doubt that some of our spirit producers are getting seriously good at their vocations. Such are the following.

94104 LEWIS ROAD CREAMERY CHOCOLATE CREAM LIQUEUR 700ML \$49.99

Fresh New Zealand cream and rich chocolate, with a touch of triple distilled premium spirit makes for a decadent treat. Warmly spicy, it's pretty enjoyable simply poured over ice, but works a treat with coffee or over ice cream.

93221 BROKEN SHED PREMIUM VODKA 750ML \$59.99

From an idea born in an old weathered shed in Wanaka, using spirit distilled from milk whey and local spring water fresh from the Southern Alps. A clean yet round tasting spirit, perfect either straight from the freezer or mixed.

93387 THOMSON TWO TONE WHISKY 700ML \$69.99

The Thomson Two Tone name references the two kinds of casks used during the maturation process. Aromatic notes of caramelised fruits accompany red berry, apricot and spicy characters on the palate.

The handmade, small batch Rose Rabbit takes its name from the two life forms that thrive in the Cardrona Valley. The oranges are sourced from Gisborne, with the peels soaked in the Cardrona un-aged single malt spirit for two weeks prior to being redistilled to a pale lemon-coloured liqueur.

The company manages its own vineyards, with winemaker Glen Barry focused on producing a selection of handcrafted, single vineyard wines. 


