

And really, who can forget the effervescent pinnacle that is French champagne? Indeed, it just goes on. However, we won't, because it's all right inside, waiting for you. Take a look.





DAGUENEAU LOIRE BLANC FUMÉ DE POUILLY 2014

Decanter named the late Didier Dagueneau as one of the world's top ten makers of white wine, opining that his expressions 'tower over the rest of Pouilly-Fume.' The Sauvignon Blanc wines of this risk-taking Loire perfectionist are legendary. Meeting an untimely end at the age of 52 in a plane crash, his brilliant legacy has been kept alive by his family via the dedicated and talented hands of his son, Benjamin.

THE LOIRE VALLEY

With its 80-plus appellations, the Loire Valley is a treasure trove, from the Sauvignon Blanc-derived, smoky, mineral-tinged Sancerre and aromatic, steely-flavoured Pouilly-Fumé to the wines of Vouvray, fashioned from Chenin Blanc and ranging from austere to opulent. The region offers a quality/bargain metric that, quite frankly, nowhere else in France can match.



PASCAL JOLIVET LOIRE 40982 SANCERRE 2017

Pascal Jolivet is one of a new breed of winemakers in the Loire Valley, producing powerful, elegantly styled Sauvignon Blanc expressions. His Sancerre is graceful and restrained, displaying the dry and flinty minerality one finds in the better French wines, complemented by a vibrant, citrus-edged finish. A masterful expression.



PASCAL JOLIVET LOIRE 40927 POUILLY-FUMÉ 2016

On the opposite bank of the Loire to Sancerre is Pouilly-Fumé, also Sauvignon Blanc country, but with its own distinct soils and climate. This is elegantly flinty, with generous white peach characters and a bright finish.



BORDEAUX

Reinforced by its imposing châteaux, the aristocratic Bordeaux holds court at the centre of France's vinous universe. The largest AOC area in France, with 86,000ha of vineyard plantings and 60 million cases produced annually, when combined with the peerless pedigree of the world famous reds, the whites of Graves and the seductive Sauternes make this a region you cannot ignore.

Château Suduiraut go back to 1580, and they produce one of the great Premier cru classé sweet wines. This is their second wine, and it's excellent. Rich aromatic notes of spicy mandarin, apricot and butterscotch on a creamy, opulent palate balanced by subtle acidity.





CHÂTEAU BOURGNEUF BORDEAUX 41195 POMEROL 2015

The oyster-shelled terroir that is one of the key components in Chablis' unique profile is now protected by law, as important as its marginal, northerly aspect. Only one variety counts here, and that is Chardonnay, which thrives in the same chalk soils that run through Champagne. Chablis is Chardonnay in one of its purest expressions, its deliciously lean styles unmistakeable.

MAINE LAROCH



BURGUNDY

The wines produced here are among the world's greatest. The only simple thing about Burgundy is that if it's red, it's Pinot Noir or Gamay and if it's white, it's Chardonnay. From there on it gets trickier. Inheritance laws have seen vineyards divided into ever smaller family parcels. In a sea of small producers, it is not uncommon for a single vineyard to have numerous owners.



DOMAINE ROMANIN BOURGOGNE 43732 TERROIR DE FUISSÉ POUILLY-FUISSÉ 2017 \$24.99 CASE OF 12 \$23.99 A BOTTLE

Romanin's Vervier Family are into their fifth generation of wine production. From the limestone soils of Mâcon and arguably its finest vineyards, those of Pouilly-Fuissé. A smart blend of power and sensitivity, poised minerality and hedonistic honeysuckle, fruit and cream.





DOMAINE DE BELLÈNE BOURGOGNE 48405 MAISON DIEU BOURGOGNE 2016 \$32.99 CASE OF 6 \$31.99 A BOTTLE

A modern winery sited in abbey buildings dating back to the 1600s, Domaine de Bellene is the vehicle of Burgundian maestro Nicolas Potel. His haunting, earthy opulent Pinot Noir wines are superb, with the Maison Dieu the starting point in his impressive portfolio.





DOMAINE DE BELLÈNE BOURGOGNE 42836 PERTUISOTS BEAUNE PREMIER CRU 2010 \$74.99

The vineyard for this was planted in 1963. This is not a wine for the faint-hearted; the palate is massively powerful. A dense Beaune packed with fragrant fruit, it balances its power with a round, voluptuous character.

BEAUJOLAIS

Officially part of Burgundy, the nonetheless independent Beaujolais froths with highly fragrant and vibrantly flavoursome reds made from Gamay, a thin-skinned – hence low-tannin – grape that the 4,000-plus growers of the region put to (mostly) good use. Almost all of them sell to large co-operatives or negociants, with Georges Duboeuf the biggest and the most innovative.



GEORGES DUBOEUF BEAUJOLAIS 42951 SAINT-AMOUR BEAUJOLAIS 2017 \$24.99

A bright, ruby-coloured Beaujolais with a perfumed nose of redcurrant, blackberry and hints of mineral. It's a lively, versatile food wine with ripe fruit flavours that linger at the finish. Popular choice on Valentine's Day.

RHÔNE VALLEY

In the north are some of Syrah's finest expressions. The south plays host to Grenache and the Rhône's peerless blended wines, Vacqueyras, Vinsobres and Châteauneuf-du-Pape. In between are the generic, great-value Côtes du Rhône wines. While 95% of Rhône production is red, there is delight to be found in the floral fragrances of a Muscat Beaumes-de-Venise or the lush apricot and crème frâiche nuances of a Condrieu.



MONT-REDON RHÔNE 41379 RÉSERVE CÔTES DU RHÔNE 2017 \$19.99 CASE OF 12 \$18.99 A BOTTLE

Established in 1344, Château Mont-Redon is one of the oldest wine estates in France and the largest single property in Châteauneuf-du-Pape. This is an exuberant, classic blend of Grenache, Cinsault and Syrah that is robust yet still refined, offering complexity and sinewy succulence via its bright fruit and earthy characters.



CHÂTEAU MONT-REDON RHÔNE 41400 CHATEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE 2015 \$49.99

Mont-Redon operate from a manual they themselves call, with some justification, 'ancient know-how'. Their Châteauneuf is a definitive expression, a fragrant nose of cherry and raspberry, peppery notes and toasty oak, the palate delivering plum, berry, chocolate and spice, seamlessly integrated and wrapped in supple tannins.

SOUTH OF FRANCE

Down along France's southern coast, the restrictions of the Appellation Contrôlée system in general give way to a freedom around vine cultivation. The benign climate delivers long, sunny days for ripening, while a moderating coastal influence keeps much disease at bay. The current wave of winemakers are intent on quality, and extolling the attributes of their terroir.



PAUL MAS SOUTH OF FRANCE 43950 SAVIGNAC VIEILLES VIGNES CARIGNAN 2016 \$14.99

The fruit for this single vineyard Carignan is sourced from old vines in Languedoc. Spice and blackberry dominate the aromatics, while the palate is lush and full, the dark fruit and liquorice notes intertwined with soft, velvety tannins.

GROWER CHAMPAGNES

In places like the UK and New York, many of the top wine lists are now 100% Grower champagnes. These are the family enterprises, often stretching back over generations, who own their own vineyards in the heart of the Champagne appellation, from where they grow the grapes to make their own wine, often bottling it on the premises as well. If it's individuality and character you're after, the Grower champagnes have that in spades. Lacking the gargantuan resources of the big players, they are more reliant on the characters to be found within particular vintages and locations, and some would say they are all the better for it.




