





Matawhero has been part of Gisborne's vinous landscape since 1968 and is quintessentially Gisborne to its roots, a designation only a handful of wineries there can lay claim to. It was established by Bill Irwin, a visionary who pioneered the introduction of new varieties and clones to the country, and in doing so changed the face of Kiwi winemaking. In the 1970s Bill's son, Denis, launched the Matawhero brand, using his father's grapes and imparting his own colourful style to a selection of excellent and distinctive wines.

When, in 2008, Denis decided to sell Matawhero, local winegrowers Richard and Kirsten Searle grabbed the opportunity and purchased the iconic winery. The Searles have revitalised the operation. The home vineyard has been replanted with new clones, along with a number of exciting new varieties, and the production facilities were upgraded. Kirsten Searle puts it thus: 'Like the Irwins, who passed on a heritage of innovation, we strive to produce individual wines that are shining examples of their Gisborne terroir.'

The fact that you can purchase it for about half the price just underscores how much importance Peter places on value as well as quality.

His wines are always priced in a wallet-friendly way that allows enthusiasts to constantly review his often groundbreaking forays. The fact is, Peter sits somewhat under the radar because he regularly shies away from the likes of wine competitions and the recognition they can garner. He is not one to strut his stuff, despite the fact that he makes some of our country's best wines. We're confident that if you were to crack a bottle of, say, his Sun-dried Malbec, Marshall Banks Chardonnay or Hillside Syrah, you'd be back for more.

It's encouraging to see Peter's daughter, Rachael Robertson, has returned to her roots at Brookfields as Events and Restaurant Manager. This can only be good for the family business. Enough with the hiding one's light under a bushel, we say.



ESSENCE OF KIWI | NELSON

Neudorf

40 vintages from Nelson's heart-&-soul winery

When Tim and Judy Finn set up their vineyards in Nelson, the Rural Bank informed them there was no future in wine, and that they should think about sheep. As you read this, the grapes from their 40th vintage are coming off the vines. Pioneers of the region, Tim and Judy planted in 1978, and along with Seifried they forged the path for winemaking in Nelson.

One of the key criteria in selecting the perfect site was to be able to grow on Moutere Clay. There are two distinct ranges: the classic range comes off Neudorf's own vineyards, all of which are on Moutere Clay and certified organic. The Tiritiri wines are made with support from external growers. Apart from the Sauvignon Blanc, all the Tiritiri wines are from Moutere Clay as well.

The Finn family's acclaimed legacy is being continued by the dynamic Rosie Finn, daughter of Tim and Judy. The Rosie's Block Chardonnay used to straddle both fruit sources, with some grower input included; however this beautiful wine is now exclusively off Rosie's Block - estate fruit from clay soils, and a wine that Rosie herself is justifiably proud of. The winemaking is managed by Todd Stevens, who joined Neudorf in 2012 and has recently added General Manager to his job description.

Giesen

Three German brothers travelling the world find Marlborough's cool-climate conditions too good to go past

Very much a family-owned operation, Giesen Wines is managed by the three brothers Giesen: Theo, Alex and Marcel. Arriving from Germany in 1979 and planting their first grapes in 1981, they now own 13 vineyards, of which a growing number are certified organic. The brothers are committed to environmentally sustainable wine production and consider themselves guardians of the land for future generations, a philosophy that defines their ongoing approach to the business. The winery is maintained to optimum technological levels, and its selection of oak includes the impressive 1,000-litre German Fuder barrels.

Chief Winemaker is Duncan Shouler, who was, for a time, a member of the Glengarry retail family! Duncan completed a Masters in Winemaking and worked a variety of New Zealand, Bordeaux and Californian wineries before settling at Giesen. Duncan: 'We have an amazing depth of talent across the entire Giesen winemaking and production teams. Being a family-owned business we're close-knit, and everyone from our long-term growers to our viticultural and past and current winemaking team have had a hand in the outstanding quality of our wines.'

Chard Farm

Central Otago early adopters, Chard Farm are one of the key wineries carving out the region's soaring reputation

With its brutally breathtaking landscapes and searing climatic extremes, Central Otago has forged a singular place for itself in our winemaking lore. Its Pinot Noir wines are next-level and its white wines, particularly the aromatics, also impressive. In the 1970s a handful of winemakers took the plunge and established vineyards in an attempt to harness the region's unique qualities.

The stunningly situated Chard Farm began life in the 1800s as the Chard family's farm, becoming a stonefruit orchard for a brief period in the early 1980s. In 1987, encouraged by the endeavours of Central Otago's early winemaking pioneers, Rob Hay planted out his newly acquired orchard in grapes, in the process neatly turning it into a vineyard. Perched on a hillside, the Hay family channel the classic cool climate varietals championed in great wine-producing regions like Burgundy and Alsace to create some of Central Otago's finest vinous expressions.

Saving Grace

Wind, nature, mountains, people: this stylish winery's four saving graces

Saving Grace is is in the heart of the North Canterbury wine region, with the Three Deans range to the West and sheltered from the stiff sea wind by the Teviotdale hills. It can be a challenging place to grow grapes, the often fierce Nor'wester testing at times. Viticulturist Jean-Luc Dufour has tended the vines for over a quarter of a century, many of which he planted. A diversity of companion plants and the beneficial insects they encourage keep things in balance. Winemaker Krystal Palmer graduated with her Bachelor of Viticulture and Oenology from Lincoln in 2012. She has experience across many facets of winemaking and has done vintages in Marlborough, Waipara, the United States and China.



freshHop

Local craft beer drinkers are about to get a dose of extra fresh, fresh-hopped beers. In celebration of the annual hop harvest, New Zealand's best brewers gather the freshest locally-grown hops to make the freshest beers imaginable.

The flowers that grow on the bine of the hop plant impart floral, fruity and citrus aromas. Normally, these flowers are dried to preserve their flavour, to be used for brewing throughout the year. But in the process their full impact becomes muted. Fresh hops, on the other hand, are the genuine undiluted article. The greatest care is taken to expedite the transport of fresh hops from harvest to brewery. Every moment the newly extracted hops spend in transport, the more the delicate flavours and oils begin to deteriorate. Hence brewers race to get the fresh hops to the brewery in record time.

The end result of this painstaking effort are beers that are loaded with fresh organic flavour. The difference in flavour is similar to that of something fresh-off-the-vine ripe. These beers showcase the efforts of local growers and craft breweries alike. Coming to our shelves in April, they will only be available for a limited time. | TM
