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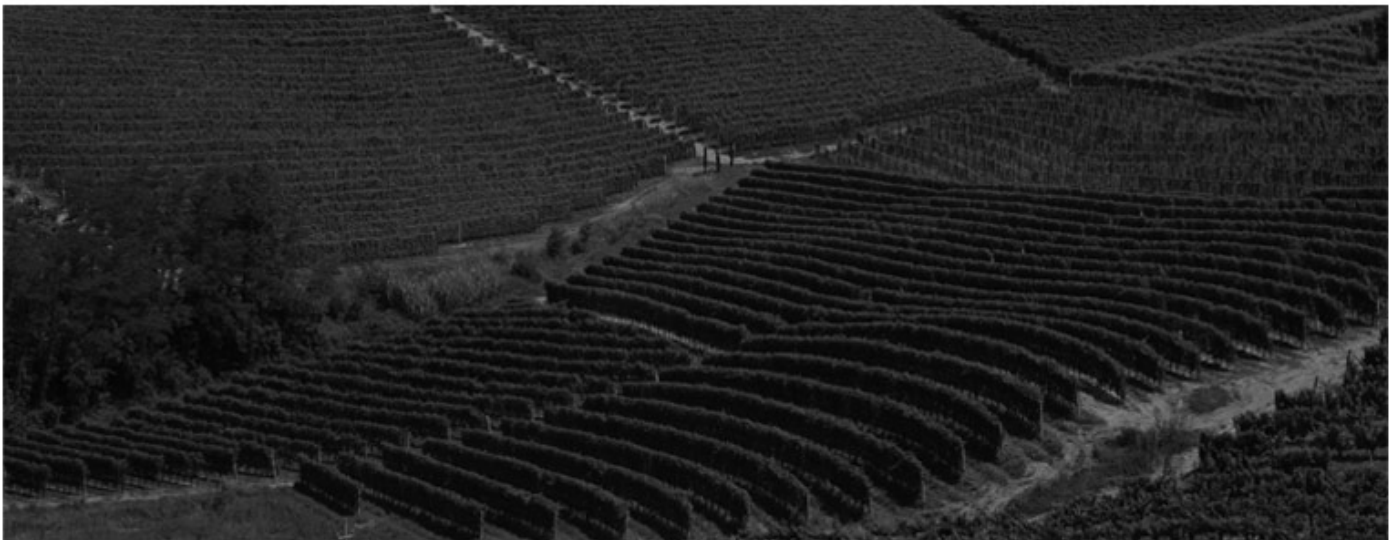

Established in sight of the fourteenth-century castle that dominates the Langhe area, Tenuta Cucco have been a part of Barolo since 1967, and have vinified Cerrati, their cru, since 1996. Biodynamic stalwarts the Rossi Cairos picked them up in 2015, and they are in the process of transitioning vineyard and winery to a similar eco-friendly regime to that of their La Raia property. The Tenuta Cucco portfolio includes three Barolo: one from the Serralunga area, the Cerrati and the Cerrati Riserva. They also produce Barbera and Chardonnay wines. A tiny 70,000 bottles are produced off 13ha of vines, with the Barolo the main event.

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Biondi-Santi

120km south of Florence, tucked away in the warmest part of Tuscany is Montalcino, where the Biondi-Santi family go way back. They are the original champions of Brunello, the Sangiovese clone isolated in the 1800's by local farmer, Clemente Santi, that evolved into one of Italy's rarest and most expensive wines, Brunello di Montalcino (first released in 1888 by Clemente's grandson, the visionary Ferruccio Biondi-Santi, who completely discarded the Tuscan winemaking manual to forge its magnificence). Not ones to rush into things, the Biondi-Santis had by the end of WWII released only four vintages (hence the rarity perhaps) in 1888, 1891, 1925 and 1945. These days the residing patriarch is Franco Biondi-Santi, described intriguingly by his grand-daughter Clio as being 'a hard man, but he has a good heart.'

Terrazze Dell Etna



Nestled into the slopes of Mt Etna, Terrazze dell'Etna has a distinctive mineral aspect to its wines. The indigenous red variety is Nerello Mascalese, its wines generally light in colour with vibrant acidity. The terraces were established in the 1800s, with current owner, Nino Bevilacqua, purchasing the property in 2006 and transforming it into one of the area's most sought-after producers. Everything is done by hand, with no irrigation other than what drains down off the mountain itself. Thanks to the harsh volcanic ground, the viticulturalist needs to cut the roots of the sometimes century-old vines to stop them growing sideways
