

PEREGRINE WINEMAKER NADINE CROSS

With auspicious beginnings, Peregrine's inaugural 1998 Sauvignon Blanc won the Champion Trophy at the Air New Zealand Wine Awards. Since then the winery has continued its winning ways, amassing a hoard of domestic and international goodies for the trophy cabinet. The ultimate goal of owners Lindsay McLachlan and Greg Hay has been to produce hallmark Central Otago wines off their own organically certified vineyards, augmented with fruit from selected growers.

The wines are crafted by Otago native Nadine Cross in a stunningly designed winery complex featuring a dramatic canopy evocative of a falcon's wingspan. Nadine: 'Our approach is along traditional lines, with minimal intervention and judicious use of oak to allow the unique flavours of Central Otago to shine through. Individual vineyards provide different characteristics, from which we are able to produce elegant, intensely flavoured wines'

With their eye locked firmly on sustainability, Peregrine are major sponsors of the Wingspan Birds of Prey Trust, an organisation dedicated to preserving endangered species, including New Zealand's native falcon, the Karearea.

PEREGRINE CENTRAL OTAGO Chardonnay 2012

Whole bunch pressed, barrel fermented, put through malolactic and lees stirred to add greater dimension and depth. A complex wine with stonefruit aromas and flavours supported by toasty oak nuances. Full flavoured and silky textured, it finishes on an elegant citrus note.

Harvested in prime condition from the Cromwell Basin, Peregrine's PG was cool fermented and lees-aged in stainless steel to retain freshness and textural complexity. Stonefruit and pear aromas are edged with mineral notes, while the off-dry palate explodes with tropical flavours tarted up with grapefruit and quietened slightly by firm acid. Appealingly sensuous.

PEREGRINE RASTASBURN CENTRAL OTAGO Riesling 2009

Sourced from half a dozen key vineyards in the Cromwell Basin, this opens proceedings with fragrant, floral-tinged notes of stonefruit and spice underpinned by a flicker of lemon. The long, intense palate displays a hint of sweetness balanced by refreshing lime accents, and bottle aging has allowed the wine to develop a lush viscous character that complements the plump apricot flavours. Something of a pragmatist, Rudi's sparkling project was a way of having a Plan B to fall back on if the Pinot didn't fly. Fortunately for Rudi, they both worked, with the Quartz Reef Pinot Noir currently benchmark Bendigo and their méthodes featuring in any list of the New World's top sparkling wines.

Located in the heart of Auckland's vibrant Grey Lynn community, the Governor Brewery was launched earlier this year by qualified Master Brewer Andrew Peacocke, his stated goal to produce a premium locally-brewed beer. With an apprenticeship at a Munich brewery and a brewing science degree under his belt, Andrew has spent useful time at a number of European outfits, including Guinness and Stella Artois. From his impressively set up premises, Andrew produces a highly authentic Munich lager.

Using Munich yeasts, this is a traditionally long, cool fermented lager with a clean golden colour and a persistent flow of tiny bubbles capped by a dense foamy head. moved the distillery to larger premises at Coudray-Rabut and planted the *Coeur de Lion* orchard. Drouin produce an acclaimed range of regional and vintage calvados and ciders that to date have won 127 gold medals.



In 2002, Didier teamed up with his friend Guy Pautrat to produce benchmark dessert wines in the Jurançon region, located at the foot of the Pyrénées and home to some of the world's great sweet wines. As with their Sauvignons, the Dagueneau approach to the enterprise involves exacting and uncompromising dedication.
