These chosen few have a heritage that runs back to Jack Daniel himself. To honour the masterful level of craftsmanship displayed by these men, this month sees the launch of a very special collection from Jack Daniel's: the Master Distiller Series.

The seven Jack Daniel's Master Distillers they pay tribute to are:

Jack Daniel, 1866-1911; Jess Motlow, 1911-1941; Lem Tolley, 1941-1964; Jess Gamble, 1964-1966; Frank Bobo, 1966-1988; Jimmy Bedford, 1988-2008; Jeff Arnett, 2008-Present.

Master Distiller No 1 is the first of this series, beginning, of course, with Jack Daniel himself, in a celebration of the golden age when his unique recipe and high-level crafts-manship practices were first initiated.

This is strictly a Limited Edition Series, with one-time-only bottlings for each of the seven, and with so many aficionados of Jack out there (me included), I don't expect this one to make it to Christmas Day on our shelves. Be in.

PIPER-HEIDSIECK

The oldest of the three Heidsieck champagne houses, Piper-Heidsieck was founded in 1785 by Florens-Louis Heidsieck. Ambitious to make his mark, F-L created a cuvée which he dedicated and presented in person to Queen Marie-Antoinette, a patronage one assumes was, at a certain point, abruptly severed.

Florens-Louis died in 1828, and his nephew, Christian Heidsieck, went into partnership with Henri-Guillaume Piper, an energetic entrepreneur who did much to champion champagne throughout the world. Christian died suddenly in 1835, and three years later his widow married Henri-Guillaume and the company became known as Piper-Heidsieck.

In more modern times, Piper-Heidsieck has established itself as one of champagne's most consistent and reliable expressions. Under the guidance of Head Winemaker Regis Camus the company has won countless awards and medals, with Camus and his team named Winemaker of the Year a staggering number of times at the International Wine Challenge, a feat encompassing the last seven years in a row.

In 2011, the prestigious *FINE* Champagne magazine awarded the Piper-Heidsieck Rare first place in its *Best 100 Champagnes* list. Under the astute direction of Camus, Piper-Heidsieck's crisply fresh and radiantly vivacious expressions have ascended, in both quality and stature, to a very high level of excellence.

This is Piper's pièce de résistance, a 70% Chardonnay, 30% Pinot Noir blend that'll age beautifully for decades. Rich, complex, intense, it nonetheless evokes crisp and ethereal as well. Extraordinary bottle.

PERELADA

The Perelada castle houses Spain's largest privately-held library, within which parchments detail wine-making practices that date back to the Middle Ages. With the viticultural part of the Perelada activities revitalised in the 1920s, and much fame achieved in the 1960s, this is one of Spain's most significant producers, the wines a scintillating blend of centuries' worth of knowledge and cuttingedge modernism. The Perelada wines have almost become standard issue at royal and government functions, such is their consistent quality and the esteem in which they are held.

A serious wine, the smoky minerality of the citrus fruit lending an aristocracy that many far more expensive sparklings seem unable to conjure up. Slightly floral, deliciously dry, it's remarkable value.

Perelada's vintage expression is brightly pale in the glass, boasting a generous stream of fine bubbles. The aromas are clean, fruity and long, the wine smoothly dry and elegant in the mouth.

BARRINGTON RIVER BLOCK CENTRAL OTAGO PINOT ROSÉ 2012

Central rosés are becoming an extinct breed; one minute they're there and the next they're gone. Here's one, though: bright raspberry hues herald aromas of sherbet and boiled red sweets that sidle onto the palate, where cherries and raspberries dance about the mouth in lively fashion before it all draws to a crisp, refreshing climax.



LAKE CHALICE DEB'S MARLBOROUGH PINOT ROSÉ 2013

Celestially touched this, a divine little gathering of all that's good about this sort of wine: fresh, clean, crisp fruit flavours and enough going on to avoid any insinuations of insipidity. Packed and ready to hit the great outdoors.

100% hand-picked Waiheke Island fruit that's been carefully fashioned, this could easily fetch double the dollars. Bright, limpid pools of crimson delight the eye, while the flavours are tropically tinged – cherries and berries, mainly, and plums. The lush flavours are tempered by stringent control; with good acid, this is refreshing but still substantial. It's tart, then, with enough stuffing to justify the unwrapping and general handing around of the cold meats.

The Gisborne Merlot fruit brings an intensity to the freshness that many would kill (or at least maim) for; being off the astute Peter Briant's wonderful vineyard, it is brilliantly clean and beautifully flavoured. Add in the Jules Taylor winemaking skills and it's a match made in, well, Gisborne, actually. Strawberries and cream, ripe raspberries, wild herbs; a pannier of pleasure.

MIDDLE-EARTH NELSON PINOT MEUNIER ROSÉ 2013

Pinot Meunier is the grape of choice here. A base varietal in the production of France's mighty champagnes, it's not particularly common to see it out on the town all by itself; yet in a rosé it works, by golly. A rich and luscious mouthfeel, with a touch of Framboise, rosewater and jasmine embraced by a juicy acidity that provides a handy dose of balance and length.



CHÂTEAU LÉOUBE CÔTES DE PROVENCE ROSÉ 2011

Jump aboard, we're off to the South of France – the procedure is straightforward: lift your glass and close your eyes, and you're there. The Leoube property is spectacular, and conveniently comes with two private beaches on the Mediterranean. This is a big wine, with rich fruit, sensuous textures and a sublimely silky palate. The quality? In our opinion, the finest in southern France.

MONTES ALPHA CHILE CARMENÈRE 2010

Chile's signature grape, Carmenère is all about rich, dark berries and fruity spiciness. The key with Chilean red varieties is not the struggle to get them ripe, but preventing them from over-cooking. Montes are longtime past masters. The Alpha is plummy but not baked, fragrant but not overtly soft. A savoury style of wine, if you like Cabernet and are looking for something a little different, give this a go. Will continue to develop for another 2-3 years in bottle.



COOPERS CREEK GISBORNE BELL-RINGER ALBARIÑO 2013

A white variety that thrives in Spain's north-western appellation of Rias Baixas and parts of Portugal, the fruit for this is all Gisborne, courtesy of Doug and Delwyn Bell. The wine itself comes across pure and fresh, with delightful hints of citrus and peach. Committed fans of the Spanish expressions, we're delighted to find Albariño feeling so at home in this part of the world.



MATAWHERO GISBORNE ARNEIS 2009

With all the work being done by Gisborne's Riversun Nursery, its not surprising to find a number of largely unexploited varieties hailing from those parts. A stylish, off-dry take on a classic italian white grape, Matawhero's Arneis boasts an exotic bouquet and an assured palate showing herb-tinged touches of stonefruit and marzipan.

JULES TAYLOR MARLBOROUGH GRÜNER VELTLINER 2013

Grüner Veltliner is a significant Austrian white variety, with this expression from the inimitable Jules Taylor possessing a deliciously perfumed bouquet, the spicy stonefruit aromas continuing through onto the off-dry palate. Pretty terrific on debut, this has become a favourite drop for many of our regulars.





TERRELÍADE TIMPA GIADDA SICILIA GRILLO IGT 2011

Grillo is a native Sicilian variety with a capful of personality, the fruit, spice, florals and mineral notes bound seamlessly together into an elegant whole. A remarkably full bodied wine, the ideal drinking window is 2-4 years. While this is an aromatic style, it does need some air to open it up; for maximum effect, try drinking it from a Riedel Vinum Burgundy glass.



GISSELBRECHT TRADITION ALSACE PINOT BLANC 2010

What is Pinot Blanc? Roughly, it's the crispness of Riesling combined with the texture of Chardonnay and the fruity approach of a Pinot Gris. Clean apple aromas lead into a great texture that's deliciously weighty, yet taut and tart. There's a slight hint of sweetness, but really, it's the texture that pulps your pipfruit.





DYNAMIC SUBCONTINENT



MONTES ALPHA CHILE CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2010

One of Chile's top Cabernet Sauvignons from one of its finest producers, aged for twelve months in French oak barrels. Intensely ruby-hued in the bottle, heady notes of blackcurrant, chocolate and cigar box regale the nose. There is a fair degree of complexity in the full-bodied and balanced palate that's signed off with a lengthy and remarkably persistent finish.

With the fruit languishing 1,067 metres above sea level, 'Terraces of the Andes' is the ideal name for these wines. This is classic Argentine Malbec, darkly elegant with intense notes of blackberry, cherry and plum. The concentrated flavours possess an appealing smooth delicacy and the finish lingers most appealingly.

Surgingly fruity, with a preponderance of plums and a blather of blackberries. Nice spice, not posh and far too cool to be sporty. It's all about the fruit, and a very generous weight and length, especially given that price point. Think big; buy a case.



MONTES LIMITED SELECTION CHILE CABERNET CARMENÈRE 2011 WAS \$21.90 NOW **\$18.99** 90576

Now very much at home in Chile, Carme; nère was originally planted alongside the Cabernet vines in Bordeaux; fitting, then, that it is blended here with its old associate, which takes 70% of the reins. The ample, medium-weighted palate is softly generous, with smooth tannins and a long aftertaste.



CHAKANA RESERVE ARGENTINA MALBEC 2011

This is impressive; the colour alone would have you weep purple prose, the perfume so seductive if you tire of drinking you can always dab it on. Tightly woven aromatics of deep berries, wood, coffee, and leather so smooth you'll slip; the palate is rich, chewy and meaty/savoury with the berries getting inkier.

Elsewhere utilised as a component of Bordeaux-style blends, within Argentina the inky and intense Malbec is unopposed king; as the most widely planted red variety in the country, it feels no need to share the bottle

with anyone. Characterised by deep, rich colours, intense, spicy flavours and velvet-lined tannins.

One of our great Chardonnays, no question.



VILLA MARIA PRIVATE BIN HAWKES BAY ORGANIC MERLOT 2011

The Villa Maria stalwarts lead the charge, as ever, with this amiably-priced organic offering, A dark crimson hue paves the way to a vibrant nose of red plum, boysenberry and subtle spice with cedary undertones. The soft and generous palate combines with silky tannins to make this an excellent food wine.

Gisborne's James and Annie Millton know a thing or two about the green winemaking revolution; one of New Zealand's original, pioneering organic and biodynamic wineries, they have also mastered the wily Chenin Blanc and are currently producing a variety of styles under their well-known Millton label. They augment that range with an accessible, ready-to-drink offering under the Crazy By Nature banner.

LOVEBLOCK MARLBOROUGH SAUVIGNON BLANC 2012

The remarkable Kim Crawford emerges once again with his latest venture, Loveblock, an organic winery developed with Erica Crawford. Those paying attention will note the label says 'made with organic grapes' – that is an export term to meet American requirements. The lifted aromatics are peach, fig and a touch of tomato, while the palate evokes white peach and subtle herbaceous notes with a edge of linear acidity.





ARROGANT FROG PÉZENAS RIBET ROUGE RURAL 2011

Who says the French don't have a sense of humour? The Arrogant Frog approach involves combining French know-how with screwcaps. The annual Victoria Park Pétanque Tourney aside, may it be said that this southern French red belle has all the fruit, charm and flavour you could want, with none of the arrogance. Jean-Claude Mas comes from a family with a long tradition of winemaking in southern France, dating right back to 1892. In the Arrogant Frog wines he combines, successfully, all of that accumulated history with a thoroughly modern outlook.



PUTTING THE FIZZ IN EVE'S DOWNFALL

ZEFFER DRY MATAKANA APPLE CIDER 330ML

Born and bred just north of Auckland in the town made famous by its farmer's market, Matakana, it was, in fact, said market where this first became available for purchase. It is a crisp, refreshing drop with a light sparkle and a dry finish, every mouthful pre-soaked in northern coastal sun. Struts its green apple tang without the assistance of any artificial add-ons.





SINGLE **\$6.99** 91670

A boutique producer established by Sam Cooney, an experienced winemaker with time in NZ, Australia and France. Modelled on the lighter French styles, this is made from Hawkes Bay Braeburn apples and handpicked elderflower blossoms. Subtle floral, honeyed aromas introduce a fresh palate with citrus and tropical characters, crisp acidity and rich textures.



CHRISTIAN DROUIN

SINGLE \$11.99 92093

The Brut is a blend of about thirty apple varieties, with most bitter and rich in tannins that provide body, along with some sweeter, softer varieties for flavour and balance. Light and fruity, it is an elegant, lowalcohol, semi-sparkling cider with a clean refreshing character. Can fly solo, but rather good when paired with pork or fish.

ASPALL ORGANIC SUFFOLK CYDER 500ML

The Chevallier family has lived in Aspall Hall Farm in Suffolk since 1702, and the company is still owned and operated by the 8th generation, using recipes handed carefully down through the generations. Their Organic Cyder displays fruity aromas of traditional bittersweet apple with floral and spicy overtones, while the rich palate is initially full and slightly sweet, with good balancing acidity and a long, dry finish.



HADE IN NELSON, NEW EDUNESE Feijoast & cider

Plenty of sun in Nelson to kick this sparkling, mediumdry traditional cider along. Carefully fashioned by the region's craft-oriented McCashin family, the Rochdale is the perfect anytime drink with its well-rounded flavours and light, crisp finish. Following on with the green-tinged sensibilities to this page there are, yet again, no preservatives allowed near this baby.

OLD MOUT NELSON FEIJOA & CIDER 1250ML



With the hardy feijoa a firm Kiwi favourite that has claimed the hearts and minds of a nation, someone was always going to do the cider dance with it. Old Mout combine their awardwinning feijoa wine with their apple-based cider, the result a lightly sparkling, richly flavoured concoction that daintily refreshes as it delivers its sweet, zesty tang. All packaged up in a handy size at an even handier price.



SUFFOLK CYDER



Described by the chef de cave as a contemporary classic, the latest Dom Pérignon is a vintage that has been somewhat ignored in certain circles, possibly because of its overarching normalcy, with many of the recent vintages throwing up truly unique wines, thanks to the less than standard growing conditions that accompanied them. Dom's 2004 vintage stands out for its reassuringly predictable characteristics; it is racy, singular and a pure expression of terroir. A collector's Dom, one for the cellar.

DOMAINE BOURILLON-DORLÉANS ELEGANT CHENIN BLANC MASTERS

The Bourillon family have been making wine at Rochecorbon, in the Vouvray appellation of the Loire Valley, for generations. Records show the estate was founded as far back as 1875, but it was not until 1921 that it was organised as it is today by Gaston Dorléans.

Still very much a family concern, the domaine is today run by Gaston's great grandson, Frédéric Bourillon, who has consolidated the family's 26.5-hectares of vineyards and constructed a modern winery complex to service them. The Bourillons continue to make their wines using a traditional approach, with the immaculate Rochecorbon vineyards sustainably managed and the Chenin Blanc fruit for their highly characteristic Vouvray wines hand harvested and matured in the medieval caves alongside the winery.

The Bourillon-Dorléans range includes their sec, demi-sec and lusciously aromatic moelleux styles, all elegantly epitomising the unique vinous expression that is the Loire's Chenin Blanc.

Bourillon-Dorléans are leading-edge practitioners in Vouvrayland, with owner-winemaker Frederic Bourillon quite the character. In contrast to his smile-inducing but somewhat brash nature, the wines abound with signs of elegance and finesse. Exclusively Chenin Blanc, this is a great alternative to Chardonnay, the honeyed palate weighty, with nuances of chalk and lime and a mouth-tingling texture, all signed off with a stunningly long finish.

Included by Robert Parker in the World's Top 100 wine companies, Torbreck was established in the mid-1990s when ex-lumberjack David Powell began to nurture back to life a few plots of near lifeless, drygrown old vines in the Barossa Valley, in time harvesting enough grapes to make his first batch of wine. His low-yielding Shiraz, Grenache and Mourvèdre wines are made utilising traditional methods and minimal intervention. Torbreck also makes white wines from the Rhône varietals Viognier, Marsanne and Roussanne.

In 2002, Torbeck bought the historic Hillside vineyard, one of the Barossa's original properties, and in 2008 a new winery was completed. The facility includes temperature-controlled cellars and a bottling line for the estate wines that are redefining the expectations of what the Barossa Valley can offer.
