In the fifteen-odd years since it released its first wine, Craggy Range has firmly established itself as one of our national vinous treasures, thanks in no small part to their production, year after year, of consistently brilliant wines.

Anthony Rose of the UK's Independent Newspaper put it thus: 'If you don't know Craggy Range, get acquainted, because I can't think of another wine company that's managed to roll Bordeaux, Burgundy, Loire and Rhône styles into one harmonious group of wines so successfully.'

Right from the start, founders Terry Peabody and Kiwi viticulturist Steve Smith MW made the bold decision to pursue a single vineyard winemaking philosophy, to select the best sites in New Zealand and plant vines suited to that terroir.

Under the supervision of Chief Winemaker Matt Stafford, the wines are fastidiously crafted in small batches within two separate high-tech wineries (one for whites and one for reds). The portfolio of single vineyard wines are New World classics, and this single-minded winery is producing some of the finest and best value wines in the world.

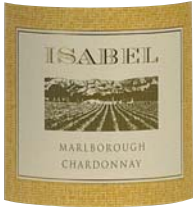

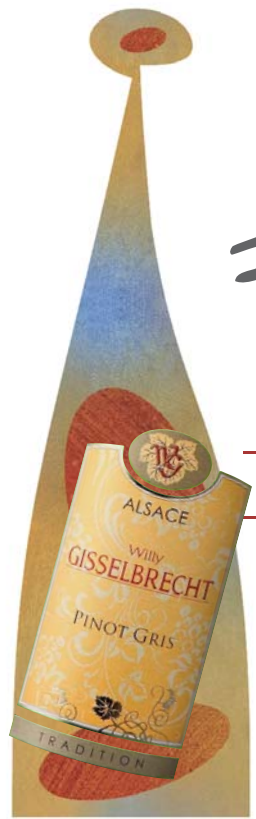

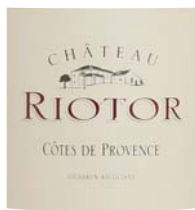

CRAFT INVERCARGILL

What began as some sort of bonding hobby for father & son team Gerry and Steve Nally has grown to become one Invercargill's most treasured enterprises. Following an extended European OE, chemistry graduate Steve initially played around a bit with cider but then got serious, and in 1999 set up a brewery with his dad in a disused dairy shed on the outskirts of town. By 2005, the brewery had outgrown the dairy shed and they moved it to downtown Invercargill, into a custom-built, self-contained set-up from where the two continue to dispense their own brand of southern magic.

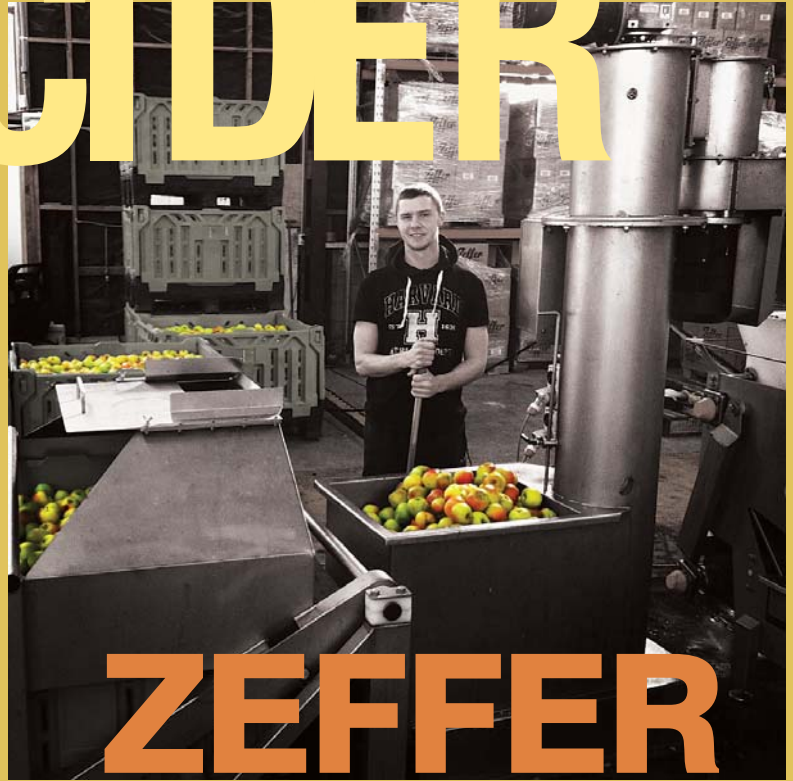

On debut, the Bishop won a gold medal and Best in Class at the BrewNZ Awards.

ZEFFER

Sam Whitmore and Hannah Bower acquired a taste for cider during a stint travelling through Europe, and the penny dropped between them that New Zealand, with its abundance of top-quality fruit, was ideally suited to the production of such an elixir. In 2009 they started the Zeffer Brewery in the lush surrounds of Matakana. Their ciders are, of course, crafted from freshly-crushed fruit, fermented naturally and free of any compromising additives. Their goal? To deliver crisp, uniquely antipodean expressions to challenge the traditional ciders they enjoyed on the other side of the world.

The wines below come from the 4-hectare Trust Vineyard within the Gravels, which combines high plant density with extremely low yields per vine, in the pursuit of ultra-premium wines.

MICHEL GROS

EXTENDING A BURGUNDIAN DYNASTY

The Gros family's winemaking dynasty began in 1830 when 26-year-old Alphonse Gros set up in Vosne-Romanée. Six generations on, the properties have been divided up amongst family members, and there are now four separate Gros domaines. Today Michel Gros heads up his own, consisting of his Clos des Réas (Premier Cru) property, along with excellent parcels in Vosne-Romanée, Nuits-Saint-Georges, Morey-Saint-Denis, Chambolle-Musigny and the Bourgogne appellations.

The vineyards are meticulously managed on a low-yield regime, with all fruit hand harvested and traditionally fermented using cultured yeasts, which Michel believes provide greater finesse. His attention to detail has been rewarded with numerous accolades, including Best Winemaker and Best Pinot Noir at London's famed International Wine Challenge, two years in a row.

The grape of choice for white Burgundy is, of course, Chardonnay; here it was harvested by hand and initially cool fermented in tank before being transferred to barrel to complete the fermentation process. Following six to eight months of maturation, the wine was gently filtered and bottled. Aromas of stonefruit and lime are accompanied by nutty nuances, over a palate of well-defined fruit displaying a creamy suppleness and a crisp, spice-edged finish.

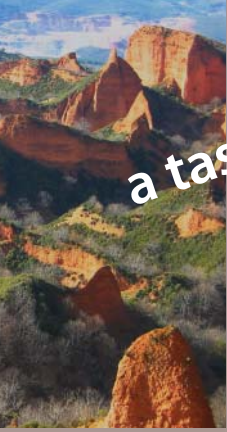

THE REAL DEAL: SPAIN'S BEST-KEPT SECRET

Sherry, in its authentic form, is one of the greatest and most distinctive vinous styles ever created. A fortified wine, it is derived from the Sherry Triangle, a strictly limited region in southern Spain formed by three different towns: Jerez de la Frontera, Puerto de Santa Maria and Sanlucar de Barrameda.

The various styles, from the driest to the sweetest, are made mainly from the Palomino grape (some sweeter styles use the Pedro Ximenez variety), and employ the traditional *solera* aging system where wines from different stages are blended together to maintain quality and consistency within the house style.

According to sherry authority Julian Jeffs, 'no one makes better sherry than Valdespino, nor does anyone have a longer history.' This outstanding producer has been involved in the trade since 1430, and its sherries offer a diverse range of styles and flavours, with aperitifs to stimulate the palate and sweeter styles to savour alone, or with cheeses and desserts.

WOLF BLASS ICONIC AND UNCOMPROMISING

Wolfgang Blass arrived in Australia in 1961 armed with a winemaking degree from Germany and sparkling wine experience in France and Austria. After a few years spent gathering experience within the Australian industry, Blass commenced blending small quantities of red wine to be released under his own label. In 1969 he purchased a two-hectare block in the Barossa Valley, and in 1973 the Wolf Blass Winery was officially up and running.

In 1974, Wolf Blass took out the coveted Jimmy Watson Trophy at the Melbourne Wine Show, a feat he achieved three years in a row. He again made history in 1999, winning the trophy for an unprecedented fourth time.

Today the Wolf Blass brand boasts a formidable reputation for premium wines, having won more than 3,000 awards at wine shows, including Red Winemaker of the Year at the 2008 International Wine Challenge in London.
