

The criteria for inclusion is simple; sparkling wines must be made in the traditional manner, with the second fermentation in the bottle and the wine undergoing 18 months aging on lees; the fruit must be 100% Marlborough, with the three permitted varieties Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier. Since September, MM has grown to include eleven wineries, ten of which are available from Glengarry stores this month.

2013 was an exceptional vintage across New Zealand, with Villa Maria's Wairau Reserve proving to be a particular standout amongst its many high points. The rich and fragrant palate is textural and generous, evoking a refreshing style of Sauvignon Blanc that has you reaching for a second glass.

18204 KUMEU RIVER KUMEU VILLAGE KUMEU CHARDONNAY 2010

Tips its hat to Burgundy and its classification levels, as well as that style of Chardonnay, the one that inspired Michael Brajkovich. Partially barrel fermented and lees aged, this has plenty of complexity, weight and texture. Deservedly touched with gold.

Jean-Francois Bordet has forged a wonderful union between the old and the new and taken his 16-century family house to another level. With its close-planted low vines, the Ara vineyard leaves you feeling a little more like you're in Europe than New Zealand. The combination of brilliant fruit with the serious skills of Jeff Clarke means this single estate Gris delivers well above its pricepoint. Pears, nectarines and spice linger fragrantly.

CHARD FARM CENTRAL OTAGO PINOT GRIS 2012 \$21.99 CASE OF 12 \$21.00 A BOTTLE

Carved into a hillside within a breathtaking landscape, Central pioneers Chard Farm are stand-out performers, their winemaking smarts beyond dispute. Here, bold characters of cinnamon-soaked pears and a hint of flowers lead to a weighty, wondrous wine laced with mineral magic.

The second wine of First Growth Sauternes sultans, Château Suduiraut, the Castelnau is a gem. Mandarin, apricot and butterscoth aromas are washed with spicy, gingery notes, followed by a rich, creamy palate that's balanced by just the right amount of acidity. Delightful as it is, but cellar some as well.

41623 CHÂTEAU NICOT

One of the best kept secrets instore right now, and an exceptional deal. The nose is dominated by lifted florals complemented by an array of clove, spice and blueberry. The palate is silky and smooth, showing sweet, spicy fruit with notes of black olive and red currant. A lovely choice for the Christmas table.

10080 AKARUA RUA CENTRAL OTAGO PINOT NOIR 2012 \$22.99 CASE OF 12 \$21.00 A BOTTLE

Nothing short of a Central Otago fruit bowl, this is highly seductive and wonderfully affordable; Akarua's drink-now model is extremely user-friendly, notes of cherry, violet and rosewater wafting in its wake as it travels the Silk Road with its bundle of spice. Fresh, fruity, juicy and good to go.

14935 MT DIFFICULTY ROARING MEG CENTRAL OTAGO PINOT NOIR 2012

\$25.99 CASE OF 12 \$25.00 A BOTTLE

Mt Difficulty's drink-now Pinot is your classic Central Otago fruit explosion, with all the red and black berry characters released in a soothingly smooth hush of crushed fruit, windblown herbs and subtle spice. A gentle dollop of the good earth seals the deal.

19311 TWO PADDOCKS PICNIC CENTRAL OTAGO PINOT NOIR 2012

Not a second-tier Pinot Noir, this is, rather, a wine produced from younger vines that are particularly expressive of the Central Otago terroir. A vibrant ruby wine with a fragrant bouquet of cherry and plum deftly embellished by a touch of spicy oak. Beautifully crafted and approachable.

17124 PEREGRINE

CENTRAL OTAGO PINOT NOIR 2011

Pinot loves Central, the extremes in temperature being somewhat similar to those in Burgundy. This is markedly different: a host of charred cherries assail the nose, and it's a perfect example of the iron fist in the velvet glove: powerfully subtle, concentrated yet balanced and opulently restrained.

GRANDE CUVÉE BRUT NV

CARTE BLANCHE BRUT NV

The Drappier house is wonderous value, its sheer quality extremely underrated. An explosive, rich and toasty nose emanates from the fresh, creamy palate. Out of all of the champagnes here, this has utilised the lowest amounts of sulphur; the low dosage also makes it one of the driest.

43501 DRAPPIER

CARTE D'OR BRUT NV

Drappier once again delivers superb value for the amount of dollars required. Stonefruits abound, a hint of sweet briar, some complex minerality followed by a rush of lush richness that pushes the parameters in a most beguiling way. Like its sibling, this is low sulphur, low dosage.

48118 PIPER-HEIDSIECK CUVÉE BRUT NV

They continue to ramp up the quality at Piper-Heidsieck without dialling down the exuberant charm one iota. The NV bursts with citrus/orange juiciness, surges forth on a wave of grilled toast and marzipan then soars to an apogee of excitement. Fruity, fragrant, it's on the medium side. The perfect party wine.

40010 NICOLAS FEUILLATTE BRUT RÉSERVE NV

During World War I, while her husband Louis was away serving at the Russian front, the proactive Louise Sipp purchased the Domaine's first vineyard plots around the Alsatian commune of Ribeauvillé, and by 1920 this budding winery had won its first awards.

No slouches themselves, Louis and his son Auguste expanded the business between Wars I and II, digging deep cellars and establishing a new processing plant. After the cessation of hostilities, the cellars were expanded and further vineyard parcels were acquired, making it the largest winegrowing domain in Ribeauvillé.

Today the Domaine is managed by Louis' great grandson Etienne, who has converted the operation to organic production. The company combines traditional methods with modern equipment, the grapes all hand harvested and the wines produced from local wild yeasts. The resulting expressions display great finesse and a true affinity for their Ribeauvillé terroir. One of Alsace's top producers, Louis Sipp are renowned for delivering some of the region's best value.
