

For all their modest beginnings as a three-hectare hobby vineyard, these guys have managed over time to establish a highly credible rep, and really, there's been no looking back from that first gold medal for their first-ever Pinot Noir.

Resident genius in the winemaking department is the ultra-talented Malcolm Rees-Francis, a gent who looks as if he's not long out of uni but who has in fact been at the helm now since 2006; so a while in the saddle. He is a big fan of letting the fruit and its terroir do the talking, and by the look of the awards cabinet, he's got the mix about right.

And it's not just the Pinot that's kicking it, their Stolen Kiss rosé, for instance, is incredibly popular and sells out in a minute, leaving in its wake each year a bevy of frustrated punters (clue: it's instore and online right now, so be in while you can). In fact, the highest quality extends throughout the entire portfolio, with excellence across the board the primary objective.



One of Rockburn's star attributes is their unrelenting consistency. Thus we have lifted aromatics, silky textures, some anchoring earthy notes and just the right amount of oak, integrated into a superbly harmonious whole. ROCKBURN CENTRAL OTAGO TEN BARRELS PINOT NOIR 2012

#### 19364 DUSKY SOUNDS MARLBOROUGH SAUVIGNON BLANC \$9.99 CASE OF 6 \$8.99 A BOTTLE

Balance is the key word here; just the right amount of everything makes this great-value Sauvignon Blanc an exceptionally good buy and a popular seller. Classic Marlborough traits emerge from the glass, so a hint of asparagus, restrained acidity, vibrant tendencies and a crisp, clean finish are all present.

#### 12244 THE NED MARLBOROUGH SAUVIGNON BLANC 2014 \$14.99 CASE OF 6 \$13.99 A BOTTLE

Brent Marris' winery continues the line of winning wines produced under his stewardship (think Wither Hills, located at the back of the Waihopai Valley). Upon opening, the vibrancy and the pungent nature of the fruit is immediately apparent, the balance on the palate precise, the length just right.

#### 13107 TE PA MARLBOROUGH SAUVIGNON BLANC 2014 \$16.99 CASE OF 6 \$15.99 A BOTTLE

Worthy descendant of Te Pa's much-lauded 2011 Sauvignon Blanc. Attractive notes of grapefruit and lime enchant the nose, while the lively palate is a treasure trove of intense, concentrated flavours woven together by complex mineral characters. Signs off with a satisfyingly long and juicy finish.

#### 11237 RIMAPERE MARLBOROUGH SAUVIGNON BLANC 2013 \$17.99 CASE OF 12 \$16.99 A BOTTLE

A joint venture between the Rothschild family and our own Craggy Range. For their New Zealand outing, the Rothschilds looked to Marlborough, comparing the tropical, textural Sauvignon found there to that of the Graves region in Bordeaux. Delicate and aromatic, there's a touch of mineral to this class act.

#### 19568 VILLA MARIA MARLBOROUGH TAYLORS PASS SAUVIGNON BLANC 2014 \$21.99 CASE OF 6 \$19.99 A BOTTLE

Absolute scorchers, these single vineyard wines of Villa Maria's. Herbs meet tropics in a rush of momentous momentum. Full-throttle fruit on the palate, rich, warm and wide, and while loads of minerality wash through on the midpalate, the acid keeps a sure hold on it all.

#### 19481 VIDAL HAWKES BAY ESTATE CHARDONNAY 2013 \$12.99 CASE OF 6 \$11.99 A BOTTLE

These guys are getting a name for themselves as Chardonnay superstars; their entry level version is a show stopper. Off the coastal zone of Te Awanga and Ohiti Gravels, this is a classic cool climate Chardonnay. Flaunting ripe stonefruit, grapefruit and citrus characters, it's enticingly fruity and vibrant.

#### 18204 KUMEU VILLAGE KUMEU CHARDONNAY 2012 \$14.99 CASE OF 12 \$13.99 A BOTTLE

Tips its hat to Burgundy and its classification levels, the style of Chardonnay that inspired Michael Brajkovich. There's an undeniable minerality, balance and winemaking prowess at work. While this is Kumeu River's first rung on the quality ladder, there is very little that's entry level about it.

#### 13700 COOPERS CREEK MARLBOROUGH THE LIMEWORKS CHARDONNAY 2014 \$19.99 CASE OF 6 \$18.99 A BOTTLE

This single vineyard expression is exceptional value. Aromas of peach and citrus beguile the nose, nuanced by some toasty American oak. Intense peach and apricot flavours are elegantly clad in buttery textures, while a twist of lime at the end signs things off beautifully.

#### 19159 TE MATA HAWKES BAY ELSTON CHARDONNAY 2013 \$29.99 CASE OF 12 \$28.99 A BOTTLE

Widely regarded as one of our top Chardonnays, the Elston is crafted with uncompromising attention to detail. Aromatic characters of lime and grapefruit with underlying cashew and toasty notes herald a palate of tropical fruit and citrus flavours riding on creamy textures.

#### 14641 MUD HOUSE MARLBOROUGH PINOT GRIS 2014 \$14.99 CASE OF 6 \$13.99 A BOTTLE

These days, Mud House seem to have everything just right, thanks, perhaps, to new ownership and the acompanying security. Their Pinot Gris is certainly in that category: delightfully textural, with aromatics of juicy pear and sweet spices, and a full, fruit-forward palate that finishes with a fresh acidity.





#### 12826 ESK VALLEY HAWKES BAY PINOT GRIS 2014 \$15.99 CASE OF 6 \$14.99 A BOTTLE

Handpicked, gently whole cluster-pressed, a combo of freshness and natural acidity with richness and aromatic maturity. Flavours of honeyed stonefruit and pears, a hint of sugar to balance the acidity, a smidgin of spice to round things off. Great presence, loads of style.

#### 46500 **JOSMEYER** ALSACE PINOT GRIS 2007 **\$22.99** CASE OF 12 \$19.99 A BOTTLE

Josmeyer is the jewel in our Alsatian range, biodynamic producers operating at the highest level, producing dazzling aromatic wines with a purity others can only aspire to. Their Pinot Gris sets the standard, its deliciciously textured peach and honey characters travelling an endless arc across your tastebuds.

#### 44420 CHÂTEAU SUDUIRAUT SAUTERNES CASTELNAU DE SUDUIRAUT 2009 375ML \$26.99 CASE OF 12 \$24.99 A BOTTLE

The second wine of First Growth Sauternes sultans, Château Suduiraut, the Castelnau is a gem. Mandarin, apricot and butterscoth aromas are washed with spicy, gingery notes, followed by a rich, creamy palate that is balanced by just the right amount of acidity. Delightful as it is, but cellar some as well.

#### 41133 CHÂTEAU **LES VALLÉES** BORDEAUX 2012 **\$14.99 CASE OF 12 \$13.99 A BOTTLE**

Ripe and approachable, this is a Merlot-dominant Bordeaux with a touch of Cabernet Sauvignon in the mix, the plums and blackberries given a gentle nudge of spice and a helping of fine tannins. Inexpensive and easy drinking, it's a good introduction to Bordeaux.

#### 41137 **RONAN BY CLINET** BORDEAUX 2011 **\$21.99** CASE OF 12 \$18.00 A BOTTLE

Made by one of Pomerol's most celebrated Châteaux. The team at Clinet have produced this superb buy using fruit from vineyards outside the appellation. 100% Merlot, it's a wee gem that's softly seductive and totally charming.

Good company and good wine; together they make for relaxed and enjoyable times. This wonderful array of reds and whites will lubricate the celebratory wheels, a winning combination of quality and value to help make your get-togethers a sparkling success.

#### 10058 CLEARWATER COVE SOUTH ISLAND PINOT NOIR 2012 \$9.99

Combines the riper flavours of its Central Otago and Nelson fruit with the cleaner, more elegant characteristics of Marlborough. Fresh and juicy, soft and supple, this is bright, easy drinking that'll tide you over while the serious stuff is percolating in the cellar.

#### 10472 DR RENWICK MARLBOROUGH PINOT NOIR 2012 \$14.99 CASE OF 6 \$13.99 A BOTTLE

This successfully stands its ground against Pinots that sell for a great deal more. In the glass it is soft and supple, with savoury mushroom notes sprinkled over rich, ripe fruit that is balanced by the natural acidity and a mellow earthiness. Drinking well right now.

#### 42390 DOMAINE DE **BELLENE** BOURGOGNE MAISON DIEU PINOT NOIR 2012 **\$29.99 CASE OF 12 \$28.99 A BOTTLE**

An incredible wine from the formidable Nicolas Potel, it's little surprise that our first shipment sold out in a matter of months. Here's a tip: don't break all the wax off, just put the corkscrew straight through it and pull this otherworldly entity into yours. A wonderful introduction to the magic of Burgundy.

#### 11154 CHARD FARM CENTRAL OTAGO MATA AU PINOT NOIR 2012 \$38.99 CASE OF 6 \$36.00 A BOTTLE

Central pioneers Chard Farm habitually turn out wondrous wines Here, the floral and spicy perfume overlays strong red berryfruits and dried herbs. The complex fruit, spice and herbal tones are perfectly balanced by silky tannins and clear acid, detailing lovely precision, tension and length on the finish.

# PEREGRINE CENTRAL OTAGO PINOT NOIR 2012 \$39.99 CASE OF 12 \$36.00 A BOTTLE

Pinot Noir loves Central, the extremes in temperature somewhat similar to those in Burgundy. Peregrine's acclaimed Pinot is powerful and concentrated, but underpinned with a silky femininity, the exquisite fruit with its charred cherry nuances a rich and opulent delight. Superb.



# celebration wines

#### 11488 KURA HAWKES BAY SYRAH 2011 \$14.99 CASE OF 12 \$13.99 A BOTTLE

While 2011 was not the stellar vintage in Hawkes Bay that 2013 proved to be, this was made by one of our best, Kate Radburnd, and it is nicely restrained and balanced. A talented winemaker plus a cooler year have bestowed upon it the refinement you'd expect in something rather more expensive.

#### 11219 CRAGGY RANGE HAWKES BAY GIMBLETT GRAVELS SYRAH 2012 \$25.99 CASE OF 12 \$24.99 A BOTTLE

One of our pre-eminent producers, the Craggies don't disappoint here. There's a touch of Viognier present that gives the Syrah a lovely aromatic dimension, with touches of violet and rosemary complementing the spice-edged berry characters. Reclines in integrated complexity on a bed of velvet textures.

#### 41371 MONT-REDON CÔTES DU RHÔNE RÉSERVE 2013 \$19.99 CASE OF 12 \$18.00 A BOTTLE

Exuberantly rustic blend of Grenache, Cinsault and Syrah, robust yet refined, offering more complexity and sinewy succulence than you'd expect at this price. Blessed with a decent dose of bright fruit amidst its earthy characters, this delights now, but will continue to deliver via cellaring.

#### 13670 LAKE CHALICE VINEYARD SELECTION MERLOT 2013 \$16.99 CASE OF 12 \$14.99 A BOTTLE

A smartly crafted, ruby-coloured red displaying attractive varietal aromas of boysenberry and plum. The palate is smooth and medium-bodied, with notes pepper and spicy oak, the dark, ripe fruit flavours showing hints of chocolate, gentle tannins and a bucket-load of charm. Good value.

#### 14531 MILLS REEF HAWKES BAY RESERVE MERLOT MALBEC 2013 \$19.99 CASE OF 12 \$18.99 A BOTTLE

A blend of 79% Merlot and 21% Malbec, spicy aromatic notes of blackcurrant, boysenberry and violet gracing the nose. The palate is generous, supple and smoothly textural, with intense characters of brambly berryfruit, chocolate, leather and spice surging towards a long, lingering finish.

#### 13763 COOPERS CREEK HAWKES BAY METALS AND GRAVELS MERLOT MALBEC 2013 \$19.99 CASE OF 6 \$17.99 A BOTTLE

Comes with a dark core and bright, flashing rim. Very Bordeaux-esque (Left Bank), with a lovely mix of primary fruit and subtle oak. Not massively fullbodied, but exhibiting great balance and finesse. Tannins are soft and round, and there's just enough fruit sweetness to give the wine some real length.

#### 90133 CHAKANA ARGENTINA ESTATE MALBEC 2012 \$17.99 CASE OF 12 \$15.00 A BOTTLE

Argentina does this variety so well. The colour alone would have you weep purple prose, with the perfume so seductive if you tire of drinking you can always dab it on. Tightly woven aromatics infuse the rich palate as they charm with savoury flavours augmented by coffee and leather nuances.

#### 77405 LOS BOLDOS CHILE GRAND RESERVE CARMÉNÈRE 2013 \$16.99 CASE OF 12 \$15.99 A BOTTLE

An obscure but intriguing Bordeaux variety, Carménère thrives in Chile's phylloxera-free landscape and is a local favourite. This cerise-tinged, rubyhued wine displays generous blackberry, cherry and chocolate aromas and flavours nuanced by spicy oak and complemented by silky tannins.

#### 88060 PALACIOS REMONDO RIOJA LA VENDIMIA 2013 \$18.99 CASE OF 12 \$17.99 A BOTTLE

Produced by the masterful Alvaro Palacios within Spain's Rioja Baja region, where the sun beats down and the Grenache fruit gets seriously ripe, this is one of our biggest-selling Spanish wines. Spicy, juicy, abundantly charming, it's now on allocation due to its global popularity. Buy a case.

#### 79045 QUINTA DE LA ROSA PORTUGAL RUBY PORT GOOML \$24.99 CASE OF 6 \$23.99 A BOTTLE

This tiny, century-old family business has a knack for turning the traditional port varieties into something special. DLR use their highest grade of grapes for this, their entry-level model, and their ruby, is more intense than most, not as sweet and infinitely richer.





Waiheke Island's Hauraki Gulf terroir has proven exceptionally winemaker-friendly, thanks to its warm, sheltering aspect and moderating sea breezes off 130+ kilometres of coastline. Cabernet-based wines initially put the island on the map via visionary types like the Goldwater family, and these expressions continue to be recognised as some of our finest. More recently, the likes of Syrah and Pinot Gris have also found a little corner there to call home. 





# MARQUÉS DE MURRIETA Maintaining the Old School Cool

Peruvian-born Luciano de Murrieta founded the bodega that bears his name in 1852 near the southern tip of the Rioja Alta, in the middle of the beautiful Ygay Estate, a 300-hectare vineyard that provides the fruit for the entire Marqués de Murrieta portfolio. One of Rioja's two winemaking pioneers, Luciano studied in Bordeaux, and upon establishing his own enterprise in Rioja he introduced the practices he'd learnt there.

Since 1983 the bodega has been managed by the Cebrián-Sagarriga family. Proudly traditional (the wines are aged in wood for a minimum of two years), their approach combines methods accumulated over 160+ years with the benefits of modern technology. The vineyard is managed on a low-yield regime to ensure top-quality fruit, a key factor in the excellence of the expressions produced by this iconic Spanish winery.
