The Taste of Success

Glengarry began its journey over 70 years ago, and the ensuing period has encompassed a lot of changes for us (roll with the punches, what doesn't kill you makes you stronger, etc. etc.). Anyway, we've obviously had quite a bit of time to fine-tune things, so it should come as no surprise to at least some of you that we somewhat overachieved at the recent Top Shop Awards, the ones that acknowledge excellence in retailing.

In the Top Shop Awards 2015, the finalists received the highest mystery shopping scores among their peers and excelled in all areas of retail, including instore display, customer service and sales skills. They were then assessed by a panel of judges who looked at their mystery shopping scores, as well as their innovation, growth, investment in their people, their business, technology and retail practices and, not least, their ability to think outside the box.

From an initial field of over 600 contenders, Glengarry rose amongst the cream to have four finalists in the Upper North Island section of the Top Shop Awards (Glengarry's Westmere, Jervois Rd, Khyber Pass and Victoria Park stores) and two in the Lower North Island (Glengarry Kelburn and Glengarry Courtenay Place). The end result? Glengarry's Jervois Rd store took out the award for the Best Food & Beverage category, while Glengarry Kelburn nailed two awards, - winner of both the Food & Beverage and the Multi Store OmniChannel categories - and Glengarry Victoria Park was Runner-up in both Food & Beverage and National Multi Store.

Are we pleased? Well, you can always do better, can't you. So yes, while we are elated to have all our hard work and dedication to our customers recognised at such a level, we're going to try our damndest to do even better for next time.

With no fining and no filtering, this is one for the cellar, a supremely aromatic surge of black cherries and violets, earthiness and understatement. Sensual, supple, savoury, superb.

It took Chris Pask to see the potential for viticulture in Hawkes Bay's initially unassuming but now most famous winemaking sub-region. In 1981 he planted the first vines in Gimblett Road and kicked off the now globally-lauded Gimblett Gravels wine district, acknowledged for producing this country's premier Claret-style reds, Syrahs and Chardonnays.

Combine that astuteness with some serious talent and you have an unstoppable combination: In 1991, Kate Radburnd joined Pask from Vidal, where she had enjoyed a stellar career for seven years. She became co-owner in 1993 and was appointed Managing Director in 1999. Kate has worked 30-plus vintages in Hawkes Bay and has become one of this country's most acclaimed winemakers. Within a highly impressive portfolio, the Pask Chardonnays are particularly noteworthy.

Hawkes Bay is the spot in these parts to look for your Syrahs, and you'd be hard-pressed to find anyone there who does it better than the Pask crew, especially with their Declaration. The skill is apparent, with lovely floral fruit fragrances of pepper, blueberry and nutmeg and a palate with real presence showing hints of cassis, liquorice and spice wound around a core of supple tannins. Buy two and pop one in the cellar, is what we say.





Wineries have been filtering their wines to make them clearer for about 30 years now. Given that this can also remove elements that affect flavour and aroma, some are now avoiding filtering to maintain the wine's true character and integrity.





The story of the Pasqua winemaking enterprise began in 1925 when four brothers, Nicola, Riccardo, Natale and Umberto Pasqua established the Fratelli Pasqua Company in Verona. They concentrated on the classic wines of the Veneto region and gradually amassed an empire of significant vineyard holdings.

Ninety years on, the company is managed by a second generation of Pasqua brothers, Carlo, Umberto and Giorgio. Aside from opening up Pasqua's wines to the world, the brothers have further expanded their holdings in the classic Veronese zones, introduced low-vield regimes and invested heavily in R&D and modern technology.

They're very cosmopolitan, this current lot, as far from the image of the peasant Italian winemaker as you could possibly imagine. In balance to their urbane air, the family have accumulated 90 years of experience working the Veneto landscape, and have been big drivers of the region's success, ensuring wines like Soave and Valpolicella are known throughout the wine-drinking world. While they produce exceptional value entry-level wines, Pasqua also have a reputation for crafting beautiful top-end and Amarone-style expressions.


A TASTE OF A VISTAGE

D'ARENBERG

d'Arenberg's catchcry is 'The art of being different', and indeed, they have their own way of doing things. One of Australia's most significant and admired producers, this iconic McLaren Vale outfit was established in 1912 by Joseph Osborn. Perhaps unsurprisingly, given their idiosyncratic nature, the man was a teetotaller! Osborn may not have enjoyed a glass or two, but he learnt a fair bit while working at Thomas Hardy.

The company remains in family hands, with Chester Osborn taking over the lead from his father d'Arry in 1984. Chester is a gifted winemaker, and namechecked by Robert Parker as one of the top 40 personalities in the wine industry. Their wines go from affordable everyday to the stuff of legend. They are the only winery in Australia to use foot treading and basket pressing for both red and white wines. For Chester, it's all about handcrafted, small batch production, scintillating aromatics, texture and balance, plus a complex structure of tannins and length.

We'll leave the last word to Mr Parker: 'This admirable portfolio made by the multi-talented Chester Osborn includes brilliant quality at the top, very fine wines in the middle range and terrific value at the bottom.'






