Morton Estate have been making this for ever; their silkily creamy, longstanding Kiwi sparkler garners much respect, and is a reminder that something done well needs little tweaking. Complex, elegant, iconic.



ALLAN SCOTT MARLBOROUGH 17397 CECILIA MÉTHODE TRADITIONNELLE NV \$19.99

A fitting testament to the meticulous care the Scott family take with their sparkling wines. Silkily elegant, with a smartly tart palate and a creamy mouthfeel, this is a great drinking, great value méthode traditionnelle from one of Marlborough's winemaking institutions.



DANIEL LE BRUN MARLBOROUGH 12145 MÉTHODE TRADITIONNELLE BRUT NV \$22.99

Daniel Le Brun has an enviable pedigree. A balanced, subtle Marlborough méthode with aromas of crisp apple, brioche and citrus enhanced by subtle biscuity notes, the delicate mousse and soft, creamy mouthfeel underpinned by lively acidity.



AKARUA CENTRAL OTAGO 10118 MÉTHODE TRADITIONELLE BRUT NV \$25.99

The accomplished Akarua team produce an elegant aperitif-style méthode displaying complex characters and biscuity nuances. Creamy, textural, beautifully fresh, their sparkling expression brilliantly evokes Central Otago's unique characteristics.







Dosage is the final step before corking. During dégorgement, a little wine escapes. The bottle is topped up with a blend of wine and sugar syrup known as the dosage. This helps to balance the wine, with the amount of added dosage determining the style.

Reserve Wines

The majority of méthode traditionnelle wines are non-vintage, or NV, meaning that they are multi-vintage blends. Initially a base wine blend is created from the current year plus a percentage (between 10-50%) of 'reserve' wine from previous vintages. The reserve wines are matured and held in storage until it's time for blending and the second fermentation. Whether that storage is in oak, stainless or concrete will affect the end result. Having a percentage of reserve wine in the blend provides balance and an all-important consistency to the house style.

Charmat

The Charmat method of making sparkling wine involves mixing the wine with yeast - and with sugar if needed - and transferring it to a sealed, temperature-controlled pressure tank where a second fermentation occurs. When the second fermentation has been completed, the yeast lees are filtered and the wine, kept under pressure, is then bottled. The process is ideal for creating and preserving the fresh aromatic characters of Italy's classic Prosecco styles.

Méthode Traditionnelle

Sparkling wines can be produced in a number of ways, but the most admired are the classic méthode traditionnelle wines, using the system developed in Champagne. Following an initial fermentation, blended still wines are transferred to bottle with a selected yeast solution and sealed. This initiates a second fermentation in the bottle, creating alcohol and carbon dioxide bubbles that dissolve in the wine. Time spent on lees leads to greater complexity in the wine. Costly, labour-intensive, the time-honoured méthode traditionnelle system is the favoured process of sparkling winemakers the world over.

Dégorgement

An integral stage of méthode traditionnelle production is the process of dégorgement. During fermentation, a deposit of yeasty sediment settles in the bottle, where it provides additional nuances and complexity during the maturation period. The bottles are moved, and gradually upended so that the sediment collects in the neck. The neck is then dipped into a freezing brine solution. The initial closure is removed and pressure within the bottle shoots out the frozen sediment pellet, leaving the wine clear and ready for the final stage of the process.

Many vignerons in Champagne sell their fruit to the large established houses, but a good number of small, family-run units craft their own champagnes from their vineyards. The wines are often bottled on the premises and come in a diverse range of distinctive styles that are a reflection of the idiosyncrasies of their particular terroir. Grower champagnes are not a new concept, but the diversity, complexity and individuality of these boutique styles sets them apart from the mainstream. With corporatization of the industry so prevalent, many aficionados are developing a taste for these smaller scale, hand-crafted champagne styles.

Arguably the world's first international luxury brand. In this case, big is also good. Moët & Chandon's non-vintage rosé hits the mark with style, delivering Pinot Noir-derived richness, beautifully interwoven flavours and layered complexity.

A standout vintage in Champagne. 70% Pinot Noir fruit provides the voluptuous weight, the 30% slice of Grand Cru Chardonnay grapes contributing a mineral-edged vitality. Freshly fragrant, with rich, lingering, honeyed white fruit flavours.

Vintage Champagne

Vintage champagne is created from the fruit of a single year, as opposed to their invariably cheaper non-vintage siblings, which, to maintain a consistent house style, are drawn from a pool of reserve wines from a number of vintages. These singular champagnes champion the individual qualities of a particular vintage, which means that some years are going to be special, and some less so. It's all about the grapes being in optimum condition. After the second fermentation and disgorgement, the wine must, by law, be matured for at least three years, With the serious producers, it will be for longer.



MOËT & CHANDON CHAMPAGNE 47221 GRAND VINTAGE BRUT 2009 **\$79.00** with giftbox

Following several vintages in which Chardonnay was dominant, Pinot Noir has taken the leading role in 2009. The controlled power is the backbone of the vintage and the proportion of Pinot has not been this high since 1996. Vivacious and weighty, with focused acidity.



POL ROGER CHAMPAGNE 48260 BLANC DE BLANCS BRUT 2009 \$125.00 with giftbox

Aged for seven years in the Pol Roger cellars prior to release, the 2009 is subtle and elegant, displaying a refreshing trace of minerality. An aromatically spiced nose, good fruit intensity and weight. Stylish and bright on the palate, with good length and very pure acidity.

Grand Cru

Champagne's classification system scores the village each vineyard is located in. Working from a 100-point scale, 319 villages are graded for their historical grape growing potential. The 17 villages ranked at 100% are referred to as Grand crus. The most prestigious, they command the highest prices. Ranked just below, at 90-99% are 45 villages classified as Premier crus.

ONE EYE ON THE SKY

Taking its name from the beautiful wilderness lake in the Richmond ranges bordering Marlborough's Wairau Plains, Lake Chalice has forged a significant reputation since its inception in 1989. Its labels feature the magnificent Karearea, New Zealand's endemic falcon, with the winery assisting in bringing attention to the raptor's increasingly endangered status. Once prolific within the Marlborough region, the Karearea is today threatened by introduced pests and other human-induced hazards. Lake Chalice has long been an ardent supporter of the Wingspan Birds of Prey Trust, which helps to preserve and rehabilitate our birds of prey. The winery is also active in the Falcons for Grapes project, an initiative that recognises their ability to contribute to the control of grape-loving pest birds.
