VENETO

Veneto delivers great value Soave, Valpolicella and Bardolino wines. Less than half of the wine produced is able to be labelled with the Italian quality mark of DOC, with large quantities of IGT (table wine) produced there, making it an important region for quantity. It is also home to the superstar Amarone, and to the sparkling Prosecco wines made in Conegliano-Valdobbiadene.

EMILIA - ROMAGNA

Emilia-Romagna is a cornucopia of delights; in Modena you'll find the world's best vinegar, the ham of Parma, and the region is also home to Parmigiano-Reggiano, Ferrari, Maserati and Armani. It also has one distinctive vinous treasure in the form of Lambrusco, to which there are many faces, including high quality sparkling wines that are white, dry and quite superb.

The longest-standing producer of the Italian style of wine known as Lambrusco, Chiarli was founded in 1860 and is still family managed. 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T O S C A N A

Along with Piemonte, Tuscany has the highest percentage of top-tier DOCG wines, and is home to the scarlet giants Chianti, Brunello di Montalcino and Vino Nobile di Montepulciano. It is here that the new meets the old head-on, giving rise to the so-called Super Tuscan. The region's premier grape variety is Sangiovese, which used to make the ubiquitous Chianti.

PUGLIA

Southern Italy is all about value and generous, forward wine styles. Historically significant as the place that the vine first arrived in Italy from Greece, Puglia is located in the middle of the heel of Italy's boot. Known as a large volume producer, the region now boasts its own top-rated DOCG appellations and an impressive 25 DOC zones.

75% Primitivo and 25% Aleatico (a variety indigenous to Puglia), this is perfumed, unctuous and immediately attractive. Dry in style, it's a wonderful value rosé and an excellent aperitivo.

SICILIA

Sicily is home to more wineries than any other Italian region. Leading light on the island is the fortified DOC wine, Marsala. It is, these days, making a considerable name for itself, particularly with wines from the volcanic soils around Mt Etna.

A treasure trove of culinary delights, Piemonte is home to Barolo, Barbaresco, truffles and hazelnuts. The predominant red grapes are the indigenous Nebbiolo, Barbera and Dolcetto, the whites, Arneis and Moscato. The wines are distinctly regional and oozing with flair. Lovers of Pinot Noir will feel right at home with Nebbiolo, which is bottled in its own right as well as being the variety behind the famed Barolo wines.

The founders of Mud House purchased land in Marlborough in 1996, and while preparing the land for planting they built a mud brick home from the local earth, inspiring the birth of the Mud House brand. Twenty-plus years on, Mud House has seriously evolved and today owns sustainably certified vineyards in Marlborough, Waipara Valley and Central Otago. Headed by Cleighen Cornelius, the winemaking team produce a variety of award-winning styles, expressed through their regional, estate and single vineyard collections, which have been joined of late by the Mud House Sub-region Series, a good-drinking, price-friendly range of wines celebrating the unique characters of individual Marlborough terroirs.

Founded in 1849, the company is one of the few Grandes Marques houses still family-owned and operated. Pol Roger holds some 92 ha of vines surrounding Épernay that provide a good percentage of its needs. The balance is sourced mainly from Premier cru and Grand cru vineyards averaging 95 points. That ranks Pol Roger close to the highest quality classification possible among the Grandes Marques.

From 2001 to 2011, the winery underwent a complete renovation to ensure that each individual cuvée is vinified to optimum quality and consistency levels. Prior to blending, each fruit parcel is separated by village, grower and grape variety. Once blended, each cuvée is dosed with a high percentage of reserve wine, hand-riddled and aged in the seven kilometres of cellars (at 9.5°C, the coolest in the region) that run beneath the Épernay château. In effect, every Pol Roger champagne is hand-made. Nothing is outsourced, and production from vineyard to bottle is entirely controlled.



The 2016s are going to become hugely sought-after, particularly since the total yield was relatively low. Our advice is to get in early and squirrel away some of these legends in the making.




