The Glengarry Story

A Vinous Wave Rolls in From the West

Here's the thing: Glengarry is, no contest, the oldest independent family-owned and operated wine, beer and spirits retailer in New Zealand. Our proud local history stretches back five generations to the day in 1920 when my then 20-year-old grandfather, Josef Jakicevich, stepped off the boat from Croatia with little English, and pretty much nothing in his pockets except a healthy dose of optimism combined with a steely determination to succeed and a taste for hard work. What could possibly get in the way of that?

Josef eventually set himself up on 10 acres in Glengarry Road in Oratia, West Auckland, where he planted a vineyard, setting the foundation for the enduring family business that was to come. In 1945 Josef applied one of the first two wineresellers' licences issued in Auckland to the greengrocer's shop he had previously opened at the corner of Jervois Road and Blake Street. That address became the first Glengarry wine store, as well as the current location of Dida's Wine Lounge. In time, Josef's son Tony took over to become the guiding force that transformed Glengarry into New Zealand's pre-eminent family wine merchant.

The Government finally allowed wine shops to sell imported wines, and this gave Glengarry the opportunity to tap into a whole world of wine. Josef's three grandsons became actively involved in managing the increasing number of stores. In the 1980s and 1990s they expanded Glengarry further, opening new shops in Auckland and Wellington and launching New Zealand's first wine school, The Glengarry Wine Academy, from which thousands of wine aficionados have graduated.

The fourth generation are well embedded in the family business, strapped in and raring to take hold of the steering wheel when they've fully proved themselves and put aside their L-plates. And the fifth generation? Well, they're still working on their Lego skills. Their day will come.

All those years of hard work, innovation and experience translate into a handle on the wine, beer and spirits retail business that's unequalled in this country. Check out the photo: there's Dida Joe to the left, happily ensconced in the place where it all began, our Jervois Road store.

You don't often hear discussion about the wines of Northland, vet Samuel Marsden planted the first vines near Kerikeri some 200 years ago. A little later James Busby, instrumental in establishing the Australian wine industry, planted near Waitangi. The current vineyards there are the fruits of the Croation migrants who, alongside gum digging, planted vines. NZ's north suits heat-loving varieties and those that can withstand a somewhat tropical climate. Syrah and Tempranillo do well, as do Chardonnay and Pinot Gris.

MATAKANA

Just 40 minutes north of Auckland lies the holiday destination of Matakana. Alongside the beautiful beaches, wonderful farmers market and cinema are a collection of vineyards. The area was first planted in the early 1970s, and with 28 different grape varieties grown here, it's quite possible that Matakana contains more varietal diversity than any other New Zealand region. Owing to the variety of aspect, soil and the many different microclimates, a broad range of grapes from Albariño through to Nebbiolo flourish here.

AUCKLAND

Auckland's viticultural landscape has changed, with many of its vineyards now gone. While we once had the likes of St Nesbit out in Karaka and Collards on Lincoln Road, to name just two, the region is these days more generally divided between Kumeu and Waiheke. With little to no similarity between the two, the former is particularly noted for the impressive Kumeu River and its world-class Chardonnays, while Waiheke has garnered much recognition for its Cabernet-based wines grown in Auckland's maritime oasis.




HAWKES BAY

With viticulture having taken root here in 1851, Hawkes Bay has been a significant force in the evolution of the New Zealand wine industry. The list of pioneers includes Mission Estate, Te Mata, Vidal, Taradale (now Church Road) and Glenvale (now Esk Valley). This is a vast region, with 1.4 million hectares spread along 350km of Pacific coastline. Over thousands of years, the valleys and terraces that provide the region's diversity were formed as the four main rivers moved, leaving behind everything from limestone sands to free-draining gravels. These two soil types favour the key varieties for the Bay, Chardonnay and Cabernet Sauvignon, with forays into the hillsides also finding a welcoming home for Syrah.

TOURIST TIPS FROM ALPHA DOMUS WINEMAKER, BARRY RIWAI

A great place to get poached eggs on sourdough is at Milk and Honey near the beachfront in Ahuriri. Another special treat is the pastries at F.G. Smith, also in Ahuriri. Their lemon curd lamingtons are amazing; Smith's is also my go-to for takeaway coffee. If I'm after a cocktail, I'd head down Marine Parade and stop off at The Emporium. The newest and coolest craft beer bar in town is Rogue Hop, just one street back from the parade on Hastings Street. I love the beer and the view out over the Art Deco facades of downtown Napier.

TOURIST TIPS FROM MATAWHERO'S KIM CRAWFORD

Coffee from Far East Coffee Roasters. They have a very cool shop tucked away that all the locals know about. Grab your farm-fresh eggs from the farmers' market on a Saturday morning, which also showcases all the amazing produce that Gisborne grows in its fertile soils. Delicious pies from Gear Meat Pie Company. It's also worth an hour's coastal drive up to Tokomaru Bay to treat yourself to a paua pie. And a cocktail? Ussco Bar & Bistro does an amazing French Martini. Get up early to meander up Kaiti (Titirangi) Hill to watch the sunrise from the top. On a clear day you can see all the way to Mahia.

MARTINBOROUGH

The Martinborough region is one of three parts of Wairarapa, or as we refer to it now, the Wellington wine region (the other two being Masterton and Gladstone). The region is renowned for its scintillating Pinot Noir, despite being home to only a small percentage of what is made nationally. The old vine age produces wines with an impressive complexity that sees them extremely sought-after, with the climate also encouraging the production of excellent Chardonnay and Riesling wines.



TOURIST TIPS FROM MARTINBOROUGH VINEYARD WINEMAKER, PAUL MASON

Hands down the best place for a midweek coffee is Kitchener's in town. It's an old school kiwi café that does the best coffee, and service is always super quick. If you are in town on the weekend then try Neighbourhood Café on the square. Lovely vibe, great people watching and delicious food and coffee. For lunch head to Moy Hall Wines and try their tasty modern shared plates menu. Then later on in the day have a drink at the new Wine Bank, which has over 60 wines to try and a great view of the square. After the sun has set and you are ready for dinner then saunter on further round the square and you will end up at Union Square, at the iconic Martinborough Hotel. A great destination for a memorable meal, they have a fabulous gin & tonic list that will suck you in.



As a wine region Nelson has, for a long time, sat in the shadow of Marlborough. Steven Spurrier called it "home to New Zealand's finest aromatics", although originally it was Nelson's Chardonnay and Pinot Noir expressions that the region was recognised for. There are two significant sub-regions, Moutere and the Waimea Plains. It is encouraging to see pioneering producers Seifried Estate and Neudorf Vineyards still going strong alongside the more recent, innovative producers featured below.



CENTRAL OTAGO

The wines of Central Otago are much like its people – a tightknit community of warm and vibrant souls. While much of the talk is predictably about Pinot Noir, there are excellent aromatic wines to be found here as well, and the Chardonnay, when from the right clone in the right place, is incredibly good. Central Otago's sub-regions are where all the interest is, so while the broad brush approach is a great way to put the region collectively on the map, the future is in exploring the micro-differences.

For her 2020 vintage, Jules crafted a beautiful expression from Merlot grapes grown in Gisborne and sourced from a long-time family friend. In selecting Merlot and Gisborne, Jules found the vibrant strawberry notes that she sought for her rosé. It comes in a beautifully illustrated bottle that speaks to the hands-on approach to grape selection and flavours. Thankfully, these grapes were picked and safely back in the winery well ahead of New Zealand's first lockdown. 2020 is a miracle vintage, in terms of the conditions that the wine was produced under, as well as the quality. A beautiful rosé bursting with summer fruits – dry, delicate, delicious.

The Clayvin vineyard is a Marlborough legend. With its almost 27-year-old vines, clay soils and high-density plantings, it is a special place that produces extraordinary wines of superb concentration and richness. The north-facing vineyard is organically farmed and possesses its own microclimate, the high-density plantings encouraging a natural competition among the vines that generates a remarkable vibrancy and intensity of flavour. The vineyard produces just one bottle per vine. Giesen had been leasing part of Clayvin since 2003. In 2011 they purchased it outright. These are their flagship wines.

The Scott family's marvellous Marlborough méthode

The Allan Scott family have been turning out this gem of a sparkling wine for a very long time, so in terms of winemaking smarts, they've really got the whole thing down pat. Sitting comfortably in the higher echelon of accomplished Kiwi méthode traditionnelle wines, its worth noting that the Cecilia comes in a whole range, with the excellent brut NV accompanied by a smart rosé and the Cecilia vintage 2017. Carries the Méthode Marlborough Seal of Approval.

Two new barrels from Rockburn

Rockburn needs little introduction, the sheer quality and consistency winemaker Malcolm Rees Francis achieves the winery's signature. In producing their estate wine every year, they fill literally hundreds of oak barrels with Pinot Noir. As each is nursed by Malcolm on its journey through the cellars, they are regularly tasted. While one purpose of this is to monitor the evolution of the wine, the other is Malcolm's quest to find the individual barrels that most eloquently speak of the vintage and the site. Those barrels are set aside as they are identified, destined for the barrel range. The name says it all: Eight Barrels, Eleven Barrels – you get the drift. This year's barrel release is particularly unique in that there is not one on offer, but two. For the first time, there is a release that consists exclusively of Pinot Noir from Gibbston, and one made exclusively from the fruit of Parkburn.





Additions to their core range, however, are fewer and much more measured. The Wee Beastie 5 Year Old is the newest and feistiest of these permanent extensions.

Matured in a combination of ex-bourbon and Oloroso casks, this Ardbeg sports a younger age statement than many other whisky distilleries would be brave enough to put so prominently on the bottle. But, as Ardbeggians everywhere will no doubt suspect, this is a rare beast in that the relative youth here is heavily tied into what makes each dram of the Wee Beastie so special.

Longtime fans will remember the limited edition releases from the early 2000s – the Very Young, Still Young and Almost There – that tracked Ardbeg bottlings at increasingly older ages and culminating in the 10 Year Old. In addition to giving whisky lovers a look at the evolution of a style, these releases also highlighted that much of what Ardbeg is famous for – smoke and peat in delicious harmony – are heavily on display in their younger whiskies in particular.

The Wee Beastie, bottled at 47.4% ABV, lives up to this lineage and then some. Legendary director of whisky creation at Ardbeg, Dr Bill Lumsden, characterises the whisky as 'tongue-tingling,' and notes his certainty that it will prove popular for either 'enjoying neat or as the mouth-watering main ingredient in a powerfully smoky cocktail.'

Within the historic town of Waipu lies a boutique, independent brewery. Brothers Geoff and Clayton Gwynne started McLeod's back in 2014, when they decided to brew their own beer for the Pizza Barn, which they had owned since 2003. Their aim was to produce world-class beers that offered a sense of place from their little slice of heaven in Northland, and to say they have succeeded seems like an understatement. Winning several major awards over the past few years, notably Champion International Small Brewery at the 2019 Australian International Brewing Awards, the world's biggest beer competition, their future is looking bright.

Head brewer Jason Bathgate has been with McLeod's since 2016, building a solid reputation for his unique talents across a range of beer styles. The beautiful artwork on McLeod's seasonal brews is painted by grammy-nominated visual artist Sarah Larnach. Her skill with watercolours bring the McLeod's beers to life on the bottle. The Cove Unfiltered Pale Ale has just been re-released, this time in cans, and features her work.

Søren's first commercial experience was at Renaissance Brewery in Blenheim, where he was at the forefront of NZ craft beer. It was here that Søren honed his skills and nurtured his passion. 8 Wired was born out of this, producing incredible beers while lacking their own production site. However, in 2014, the Eriksens finally found a permanent home in Warkworth, north of Auckland. In Matakana, they recently opened the Barrelworks, the heart of their barrel programme, complete with taproom and food trucks. From their home base, they are always looking to innovate and explore the wild and wonderful world of craft beer.
