Rockburn have a winning way with Pinot Noir, honed over decades of absorbing the lessons of their searingly austere landscape and its idiosyncracies. There is no doubt that Central Otago and its extremes have charmed the enigmatic variety and made it feel at home, but it nonetheless takes fastidious attention to detail along with a hands-off, 'let the terroir do the talking' approach by chief winemaker Malcolm Rees-Francis and his team to produce these masterful wines. 

The Abeille-Fabre family of wines continues to expand under the stewardship of Pierre Fabre. So too does a focus on the environment. Mont Redon is one continuous estate sitting atop the Châteauneuf-du-Pape plateau, crafting wines from their home appellation and around the southern Rhône. The range includes a bold, fruit-forward red from nearby Gigondas and a vibrant rosé from Lirac. The most recent project at the base in Châteauneuf-du-Pape has been the construction of a new winery, cooled by natural air-conditioning using a Canadian well. Warm air is circulated through pipes that are buried below the vineyard at a depth where the ground temperature is more stable. The resulting cool air is then used to control the temperature in the winery.



Cairanne is located not far from Châteauneuf-du-Pape, and is home to Pierre's newest acquisition, Domaine de l'Oratoire Saint-Martin. The style of Cairanne is very elegant, with moderate fruit concentration – less than Lirac, Gigondas and Châteauneuf - but delivering great length and complexity. The whites have slightly more texture than the Mont-Redon style. Oratoire Saint-Martin has been farmed according to organic and biodynamic standards for ten generations. Winemaking under previous owners, the Alary brothers, involved a very low intervention approach, a philosophy that Pierre is excited to continue. The estate has been organic since the 1990s and biodynamic since the 2000s.

Those of you who have been with us for some time might recall the excellent Riotor rosé. Riotor was crafted by Mont Redon, and the name for their new Provence rosé is Saint Max. Its fruit comes off vineyards located in the inner valley of the Cuers plain, on the sides of the foothills of the Massif des Maures and on the Arçois inland country at the foot of these same hills. The vineyards enjoy the benefits of a Mediterranean coastal influence, while the inland Arçois vineyards experience a cooler climate that yields fruit of great freshness.

Grower champagnes are not a new concept, but the diversity, complexity and individuality of these boutique styles sets them apart from the mainstream. With corporatization of the industry so prevalent, many aficionados are developing a taste for these smaller scale, handcrafted champagne styles. A seemingly endless list of new terms are appearing on our wine labels. 'Organic' is one we're familiar with, accompanying the growing parade of organic goods available within New Zealand stores. Organic grape cultivation eschews the use of synthetic fungicides, herbicides, fertilizers and other artificial processes. Certification varies around the world; in New Zealand we have BioGro and AsureQuality. The biodynamic system builds on organic viticulture, augmenting it with Rudoph Steiner's principles and its Demeter certification. Sustainable practices are employed in many of our local vineyards under the Sustainable Winegrowing New Zealand banner.

Its goal is to encourage the production of high-quality wines through a combination of environmentally responsible and economically viable methods. Key focus areas are Water, Waste, Pest and Disease, Soil, Climate Change and People. While not a new concept, Regenerative farming seems to be Topic of the Day in viticulture, and could just be the way of the future. Regenerative farming is described as being an 'openminded, science-based' approach, one that looks at the entire farm as a whole and what is required to farm that into the future. Interested? Come along to hear Sophie and Erica talk about these practices and explore which is in fact better for our planet.

Nicaragua comes first for the Pellas family; their dedication to sustainability has seen the distillery recently achieve carbon neutral certification, while the rum is distilled with 100% renewable energy and over 50,000 trees are planted annually. This is the only rum to be both carbon neutral and Fair Trade certified. A true field to bottle product. Employees benefit from the company's school and hospital providing free education and healthcare.

The rums themselves are naturally aged in bourbon barrels without artificial ingredients or added sugar, ticking a couple more boxes as gluten free and Kosher. The young and light 4-year-old and the full bodied 7-year-old Gran Reserva bring a perfect balance of aroma and flavour to your tropical cocktails. The exceptionally smooth 12 and 18 year olds will transform your view on rum, while the 25-year-old is perhaps the greatest sipping rum we have in our stores, exhibiting a wonderful array of vanilla and dark cocoa aromas and an alluring texture leading to a long finish.

The apples turn caramelised on the palate, with hints of cloves and black pepper. A little water brings out tangy orange zest. Finishes on a subtle cracked black pepper note.





There's a new name in our local whisky scene, one you'll have heard of. Scapegrace is a recognised brand for spirit-loving Kiwis, boasting multiple global Golds, winning Best London Dry Gin In The World from London's IWSC and known as inventors of the world's first naturally black gin.

Scapegrace have always been destined to embark upon a single malt journey, joining our modest but supremely successful craft distilleries in showcasing our single malt whisky to the world. Their new distillery is nestled on the banks of Central Otago's Lake Dunstan, which is traversed by the pristine alpine waters of New Zealand's longest river, the dynamic Mata-Au. Central Otago is a land of extremes, delivering hot summers and cold winters, the rigorous elements ultimately affecting the angel's share, the aging process and the way the spirit interacts with the wood.

While this long-awaited first release is stamped with the Scapegrace name, it links back to Central Otago's past, carrying the mark of local distillers Doug Lawry and his son Anthony. The first limited edition batch of four bottlings includes wood-dominant whiskies of varying age statements, non-chill filtered and aged in virgin French oak, with the exception of the Timbre IV, aged in Bulgarian oak.

A story to watch, then, as Scapegrace apply their globally lauded high standards to their latest endeavour.

YEASTIE BOYS

Yeastie Boys has been successfully weird from the beginning, responsible for some of the most controversial flavours put into beer since starting in Wellington in 2008. Initially contract brewed out of Invercargill breweries, their first beer, a highly hopped and fruit forward porter, Pot Kettle Black, won accolades for its fresh take on the style. Some would argue it is a black IPA, but what's in a name where beer is concerned (looking at you, 'Brut IPA').

Funding each consecutive beer release with the proceeds of the last only got them so far, and in 2014 Sam Possenniskie and Stu McKinlay opened Yeastie Boys up to equity crowdfunding to roaring success, raising \$500,000 in the campaign's first 31 minutes. Since then, Yeastie boys has been brewing new seasonals every year in three different countries, NZ, Australia and the UK, where Stu is based.

Although keeping a relatively low profile through the strangeness of 2020/21, the Yeasties have set up shop in Auckland's Morningside Cidery, Morningcider, and continue to produce strange and delightful beers with gusto. | PC


